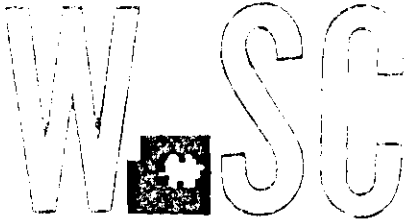
CPO Recommendation: Council "5A" recommends approval (8-0).

Background: On September 3, 1987, the MAPC held a public hearing to consider a zone change from "AA" to "C" for six platted lots totaling 2.7 acres located on the north side of Hendryx between Hoover and Meadowhaven. The property is part of Carst Gardens which was platted in 1956. The majority of Carst Gardens north of Hendryx between Hoover and Julia has never developed. A number of previous rezonings in this area have established Taft as the northern boundary for commercial zoning. No one appeared in opposition to the request. The Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval subject to replatting.

Recommendations/Actions:

1. Concur with the findings of the MAPC and approve the zone change subject to the condition of platting; instruct the Planning Department to forward the ordinance for first reading when the plat is forwarded to the City Council; or
2. Return the application to the MAPC for reconsideration stating reasons.
