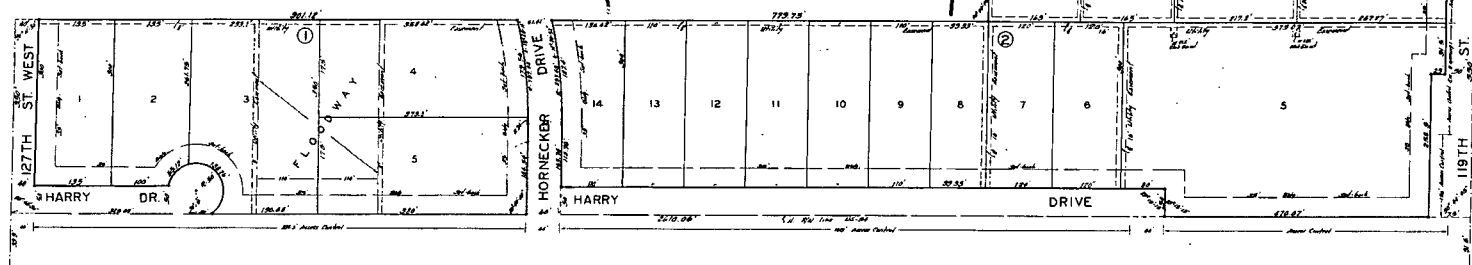

R. 24 E. thence north along the east line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 330 feet; thence west parallel with the north right-of-way line of said Highway, 485.07 feet; thence south parallel with the east line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 300 feet; thence west parallel with the north right-of-way line of said Highway, 174.22 feet more or less to the west line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence south along said west line, 350 feet; thence east along the north right-of-way line of said Highway, 200.06 feet to the place of beginning, except therefrom Hornet Drive as plotted in C-167 Addition to Wheatridge, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

Moore, and Margaret Ann Moore, his wife, have caused the land described in the foregoing certificate to be plotted into lots, blocks, streets and drives to be known as WHEATRIDGE ADDITION, Sedgwick County, Kansas. Easements are hereby granted as indicated for the construction and maintenance of all public utilities. The streets and drives are hereby dedicated to and for the use of the public. All abutting rights of access to 118th St. set over and across the east line of Lot 1, Block 2, except for opening, and across the east line of Lot 5, Block 2, except for opening, which shall be north of the section 350 feet thereof, which may be determined by the appropriate governing bodies, is hereby granted to the appropriate governing bodies. All lots shall have a minimum building pad elevation of 1312.5 sea-level elevation. The floodway shall be the responsibility of the owners of the property in the subdivision until such time as the governing body exercising jurisdiction shall assume responsibility for maintenance and improvement of the drainage provided further, that no building shall be constructed on or within said floodway, nor shall any fill, change of grade, creation of channel, or other work be carried on without the permission of the Wichita Sedgwick County Flood Control Office, or their successors in office.
