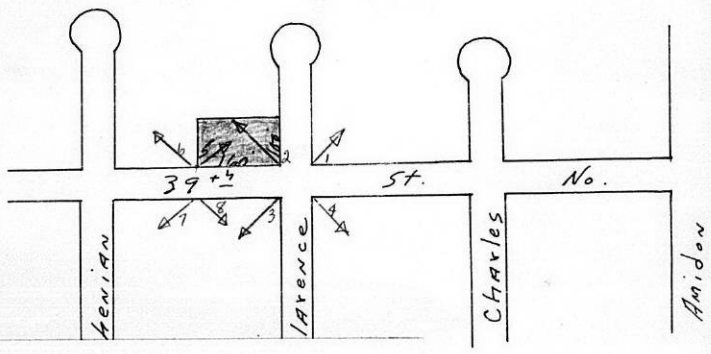

RESOLUTION
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS
A RESOLUTION PERMITTING A CON-
DITIONAL USE ON LOT 1, RIVER-
WOOD GLEN'S THIRD ADDITION,
WICHITA, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KAN-
SAS, TO ALLOW SWIMMING INSTRU-
CTION ON SAID REAL ESTATE; SAID
LAND LYING WITHIN THE UNIN-
CORPORATED TERRITORY LYING
WITHIN THREE MILES OF THE
CITY OF WICHITA IN SEDGWICK
COUNTY, KANSAS, UNDER AUTHORITY
GRANTED BY SECTION 4A10
AND SECTION 11E OF THE SEDGWICK
COUNTY ZONING RESOLUTION
AS AMENDED AND ADOPTED BY
THE BOARD OF COUNTY COM-
MISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY,
KANSAS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of
County Commissioners of Sedgwick
County, Kansas:

SECTION I. That upon the recommen-
dation of the Metropolitan Area Planning
Commission, after notice of public hear-
ing as provided by law, and under au-
thority granted by Sections 4A10 and
11E of the Sedgwick County Zoning Reso-
lution as adopted March 3, 1960, and
as amended for a conditional use of the
land described as follows: Lot 1, River-
wood Glen Third Addition, Wichita, Sedgwick
County, Kansas, to be used exclusively
for the purpose of allowing swimming
instructions on said property subject to
the following conditions:

1. No loud music or amplification system shall be used.
2. The time of operation shall extend from the second Monday of June through the first Saturday in August.
3. Hours of operation shall be between 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
4. Samples of swimming pool water shall be submitted to the Wichita-Sedgwick County Health Department on a weekly basis.

5. Weekly operating reports shall be submitted to the Health Department on forms prepared by them.

6. This conditional use shall be limited to a term of 5 years, or through the Executive.

7. Classes shall be limited to 12 students and public use shall be limited to swimming instruction only; and that no swimming fee is to be allowed.

SECTION II. That upon the taking effect of this resolution, the above conditional use shall be permitted.

SECTION III. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publishing in the official county paper.
