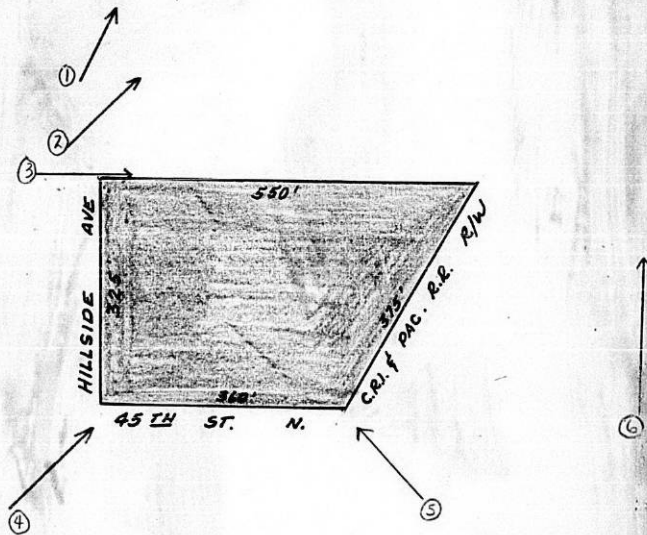

RESOLUTION
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS
A RESOLUTION, PERTAINING TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF STATE HIGHWAY OFFICE BUILDING TO PROVIDE OFFICE SPACE FOR THE RESIDENT ENGINEER AND HIS OFFICES DURING CONSTRUCTION AND OFFICE SPACE FOR MAINTENANCE EMPLOYEES, AS WELL AS STORAGE FOR MAINTENANCE EQUIPMENT FOR MAINTAINING HIGHWAYS IN THE AREA AS A CONDITIONAL USE ON PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS ALL OF THE SOUTH 3/4, PART OF THE SOUTH WEST ONE-QUARTER OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, LYING WEST OF THE CHICAGO ROCK ISLAND AND PACIFIC RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY LYING WITHIN THREE (3) MILES OF THE CITY OF WICHITA IN SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY SECTION 4 A, 1A, B AND SECTION 11, E OF THE ZONING RESOLUTION AS AMENDED, ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MARCH 2, 1958, OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS.
BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas:
SECTION I. That upon the recommendation of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, after notice and public hearing as provided by law, and under authority granted by Section 4 A, 1A, B and Section 11, E of the Sedgwick County Zoning Resolution as amended March 2, 1958, a conditional use of the lands hereinafter described is allowed.
All of the 2 3/4 feet of the SW 1/4 of Section 25, Township 28 South, Range 1 East, lying West of the Chicago Rock Island and Pacific Railroad Right-of-Way
for use as Hi-Way Office building and storage for maintenance equipment.
SECTION II. That upon taking effect of this resolution, the above conditional use shall be permitted.
SECTION III. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official County paper, passed and adopted this 2nd day of May, 1963.
