At the regular meeting of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission held on January 15, 1959, the above dedication, more specifically described as beginning at a point on the center line of 18th Street, 935 feet west of the center line of Porter Avenue north; thence north 30 feet, thence west along a line parallel to and 30 feet north of the center line of 18th Street to the left bank of the Arkansas River; thence southeasterly along the left bank of said river to the centerline of 18th Street, thence east along the center line of 18th Street to point of beginning, was considered, and the following action taken:
