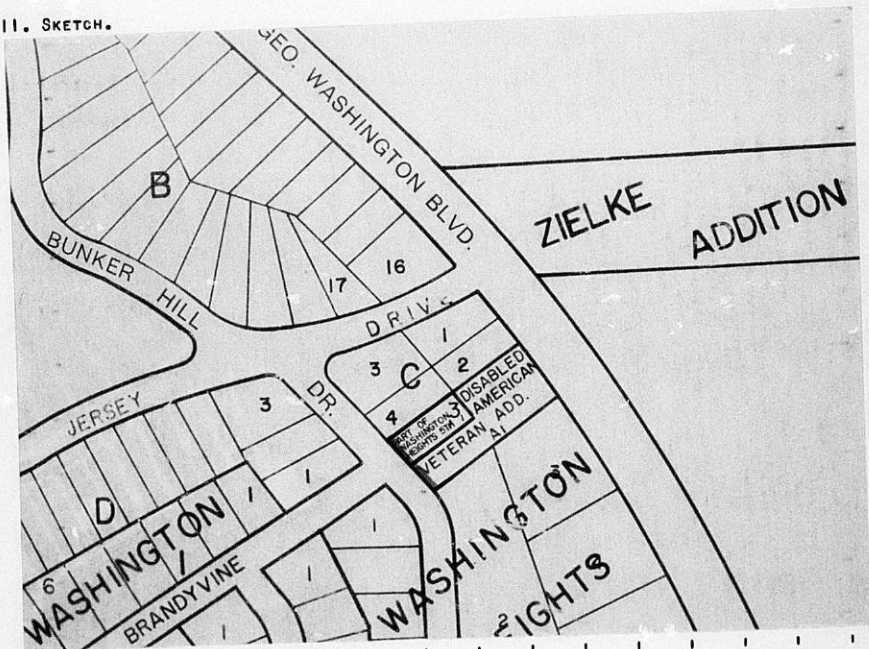

do hereby transfer and convey to the City of Wichita, Kansas, all abutter's rights of access, ingress and egress to said property from or to Bunker Hill Drive over and across the west lines of Lot 1, Block 3, Washington Heights 5th Addition and Lot 1, Block A, Disabled American Veterans Addition to have and to hold the same forever. It being understood that this conveyance is a covenant running with the land and prohibits all subsequent owners thereof and all members of the public from entering upon said Lot 1, Block 3, Washington Heights 5th Addition, and Lot 1, Block A, Disabled American Veterans Addition from Bunker Hill Drive.

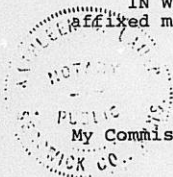
