**Ref: VAC2020-00027:** City Vacation of drainage and utility easement (0.07 acre) and Reserve A Uses (0.08 acre) for addresses on West University (6210, 6220, 6230 and 6240); generally located one block south of Maple Street between Maple Lane and Arapaho Drive.

Phil,

At the Thursday, August 6, 2020, meeting of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission (MAPC), the above-referenced vacation request was approved subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Vacate the platlor's text to remove "utilities" as a use and permit "residential structures" as a use in the platted Reserve A, Kings Court Addition, while retaining that Reserve A will continue to be used for a private drive and drainage purposes.
- (2) If any utility services are found to be located within the area of the proposed Vacation, these services shall be relocated at the owner's expense, to city standards, and the applicant shall provide Planning with the dedication of utility easements by separate instruments to go with the Vacation Order to be filed with the Register of Deeds. If relocation is not possible then this Vacation shall be rendered void as the current easement must remain in place.
- (3) Per MAPC Policy Statement #7, all conditions are to be completed within one year of approval by the MAPC or the vacation request will be considered null and void. All vacation requests are not complete until the Wichita City Council or the Sedgwick County Board of County Commissioners have taken final action on the request and the vacation order and all required documents have been provided to the City, County and/or franchised utilities and the necessary documents have been recorded with the Register of Deeds.

When all of the above conditions have been completed and there are no other documents requested; this case will be scheduled for final action by the Wichita City Council at the first appropriate date after August 20, 2020 (end of the two-week protest period). This letter also serves as a reminder that the vacation notification signs should now be removed from the property.
