SUBJECT Case No. Z-1671

In the consideration of the above captioned case, Mayor Porter raised the question at their meeting on January 7, 1975, as to whether or not property owners should be able to change their zoning back to more restrictive classification without having to submit the fee and abstract ownership list. If such decision were made, this would require publication and administrative costs plus the expense of ordering the abstract ownership list from the Planning Department budget. This matter should be reviewed by the Department and scheduled for consideration by the Planning Commission in the near future.
