AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN NEW STREETS AND PORTIONS OF NEW STREETS IN AN AREA ON BOTH SIDES OF THE I-135W RIGHT-OF-WAY BETWEEN PAWNEE AVENUE AND KELLOGG AVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

That it is hereby declared to be in the interest and convenience of the public and to eliminate confusion to establish appropriate names for certain streets and portions of streets and said streets are hereby named and after the effective date of this ordinance, shall be known and designated by the new names as follows, to-wit:

Madison Avenue between I-135W and Spruce and between Stafford and Hodson; Minnesota Avenue between Kansas and the junction of Minnesota and Minneapolis and between Hodson and Mt. Vernon; Madison Avenue between Madison and Spruce and between Hodson and Mt. Vernon; Kansas Avenue, a curvilinear extension of Kansas Avenue through Linwood Park beginning at Mt. Vernon, across Harry to Kansas; Ash Street between Ash and Spruce and between Mt. Vernon and Skinner; Spruce Street between Madison and Spruce and between Osie and Harry; Wilma Street between Aloma and Wilma and between Harry and Schweiter; Ash Street between Aloma and Ash and between Harry and Schweiter; Aloma Street, an extension of Aloma under Harry between the intersection of Wilma, Ash and Aloma and between the intersection of Madison, Spruce and Aloma; Kansas Avenue, an extension of Kansas between Minneapolis and Kansas and between Lincoln and the intersection of Minneapolis, Kansas and Bayley; Pike Street between Minnesota and Lilac and between Lincoln and Morris; Madison between Madison and an extension of the back lot line of Block 7, Roosevelt Field 2nd Addition and between Lincoln and Morris; Ash Street between Ash and an extension of the back lot line of Block 7, Roosevelt Field 2nd Addition and between Lincoln and Morris; Minnesota Avenue, an extension of Minnesota, north from Morris to the middle of the curve where it runs into Kansas Court; Kansas Court, an extension of Kansas Court from Kansas Avenue to the junction of Minnesota; Grove Street, newly constructed street that is an extension of Grove Street between Kellogg and Lincoln while lying east of old Grove Street; Grove Drive, Old Grove Street lying between Orme and George Washington Boulevard; Schweiter Court, remaining portion of Avon Street now cul-de-saced; Schweiter Drive, relocation of Schweiter Drive between Lincoln and Avon.

That all ordinances or parts thereof which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official City paper.

Vernon and Skinner; Spruce Street between Madison and Spruce and between Osie and Harry; Wilma Street between Aloma and Wilma and between Harry and Schweiter; Ash Street between Aloma and Ash and between Harry and Schweiter; Aloma Street, an extension of Aloma under Harry between the intersection of Wilma, Ash and Aloma and between the intersection of Madison, Spruce and Aloma; Kansas Avenue, an extension of Kansas between Minneapolis and Kansas and between Lincoln and the intersection of Minneapolis, Kansas and Bayley; Pike Street between Minnesota and Lilac and between Lincoln and Morris; Madison between Madison and an extension of the back lot line of Block 7, Roosevelt Field 2nd Addition and between Lincoln and Morris; Ash Street between Ash and an extension of the back lot line of Block 7, Roosevelt Field 2nd Addition and between Lincoln and Morris; Minnesota Avenue, an extension of Minnesota, north from Morris to the middle of the curve where it runs into Kansas Court; Kansas Court, an extension of Kansas Court from Kansas Avenue to the junction of Minnesota; Grove Street, newly constructed street that is an extension of Grove Street between Kellogg and Lincoln while lying east of old Grove Street; Grove Drive, Old Grove Street lying between Orme and George Washington Boulevard; Schweiter Court, remaining portion of Avon Street now cul-de-saced; Schweiter Drive, relocation of Schweiter Drive between Lincoln and Avon.







SUBJECT I-35W Frontage Roads
(English to Stafford)

Attached is a map of that portion of I-35W presently under construction between English and Stafford. The map also shows the city street system around the canal route. Although the map was originally prepared to show water lines, I have found it to be of a convenient size to post on my wall for easy reference when talking to citizens in person or on the phone about the construction, street closures, etc.

Mr. Frank Thomas, Field Engineering Administrator, Kansas Department of Transportation, has advised my staff that many of the frontage roads, labeled A through K, are currently under construction and will open soon. Frontage roads A, B, C, D, E, H and J are almost completed and will probably open later this month. Frontage road K is already open. Frontage road I is scheduled to be done in September. Frontage roads F and G have not yet been started.

I am sending copies of this to Bob Vinson and Bob Lakin so their staffs may determine the appropriate street names for these new streets. Our office will check for any signing needed on these streets (except frontage road D in Linwood Park). We will erect the street name signs when the names are determined. Street lights will not be erected at this time since KG&E's recent rate increase has again overexpended our budget.

I understand the Park Department is to maintain and sign frontage road D in Linwood Park. This is a 30-foot street. If it is parked solid on both sides, it would be restricted to one lane of traffic. The Department of Transportation indicated there are some trees in this area that may need trimming.

I am sending copies of this memo and map to the others indicated in the distribution for their information and use by their personnel. If additional copies are needed, please advise. If you know of other departments needing this information, please contact me.


