VACATION ORDER

NOW on this 4th day of October, 2022, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by Calvin McMillan & Madeline Hill Akers (owners), praying for the vacation of described portion of platted utility easement, to wit:

The North 180 feet of Fairfield Lane, as dedicated by the Replat of Spring Acres Addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

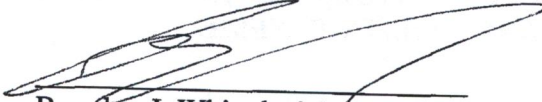
1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication, as required by law, in The Wichita Eagle on December 16, 2021, which was at least 20 days prior to the public hearing.
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the described utility easement and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the described utility easement should be approved.

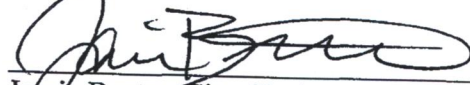

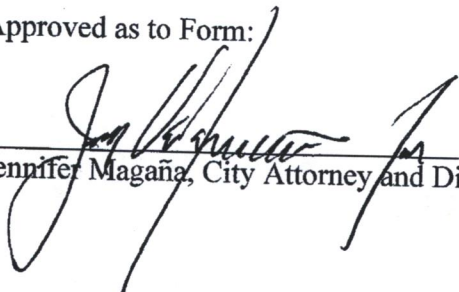
