REQUEST FOR ZONING

SCZ-0590 - ZONE CHANGE FROM THE "R" RURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT
TO THE "E" LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT, LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE
OF MERIDIAN 1/2-MILE NORTH OF 69TH STREET NORTH.

The MAPC recommends that the application for "E" Light Industrial zoning be denied,
and that "C" Commercial zoning be approved subject to platting the entire appli-
cation area within one year.

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS FOR CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN SECTION 17.C OF THE ZONING REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, DECEMBER 12, 1984, AND SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS.

SECTION I. That after receiving a recommendation from the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, and after said Planning Commission has given proper notice and held a public hearing as provided by law, and under authority granted by Section 17.C of the Zoning Regulations, the zoning districts of land legally described below are hereby changed as follows:

CASE NO. SCZ-0590
Zone Change from the "R" Rural Residential
District to the "C" Commercial District

That part of the north 20 acres of Government Lot 2 in the southwest 1/4 of Section 6, Township 26 South, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M., Sedgwick County, Kansas (now platted as Lot 1, Block A, Water-rite Addition, Sedgwick County, Kansas). Generally located on the east side of Meridian, 1/2-mile north of 69th Street North.

SECTION II. That upon the taking effect of this Resolution, the notation of such zoning change shall be entered in the official zoning atlas on file in the Office of the County Zoning Administrator and in the Office of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Department.

SECTION III. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official county paper.

SECTION IV. That this Resolution is passed for the purpose of correcting an error in the legal description of Resolution #113-1988, which was adopted May 11, 1988, and published in the Daily Reporter on June 13, 1989.
