REQUEST FOR ZONING

SCZ-0618 - REQUEST FOR ZONE CHANGE FROM "R-1" SUBURBAN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO "E" LIGHT INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT, LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF 37TH STREET NORTH, 1/4-MILE WEST OF OLIVER.

The MAPC recommends that the application be approved, subject to conditions (see minutes for full motion).

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION FOR CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN SECTION 17.C OF THE ZONING REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, DECEMBER 12, 1984, AND SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS.

SECTION I. That after receiving a recommendation from the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, and after said Planning Commission has given proper notice and held a public hearing as provided by law, and under authority granted by Section 17.C of the Zoning Regulations, the zoning district of the lands legally described below are hereby changed as follows:

CASE NO. SCZ-0618

Zone change from "R-1" Suburban Residential District to "E" Light Industrial District

That part of the Southwest Quarter and the west half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 26, Township 26 South, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M., Sedgwick County, Kansas, described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 26; thence north 89°59'00" west, 620.00 feet along the south line of said Southwest Quarter; thence north 00°00'00" east 800.18 feet; thence north 90°00'00" east, 1,956.76 feet to the east line of said west half; thence south 00°00'00" east, 800.00 feet to the south line of said Section 26; thence north 90°00'00" west, 1,336.76 feet to the point of beginning. Said tract contains 35.94 acres, more or less. Generally located on the north side of 37th Street North, 1/4-mile west of Oliver.

SECTION II. That upon the taking effect of this Resolution, the notation of such zone change shall be entered in the official zoning atlas on file in the Office of the County Zoning Administrator and in the Office of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Department.

SECTION III. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official county paper.
