REQUEST FOR ZONE CHANGE AND SPECIAL USE PERMIT

SCZ-0593 & DR 88-10 - ZONE CHANGE TO THE "F" HEAVY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT
AND ASSOCIATED SPECIAL PERMIT TO ESTABLISH A DEMOLITION AND
CONSTRUCTION WASTE LANDFILL.

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RESOLUTION NO. 250-1988

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS FOR CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED IN SECTION 17.C OF THE ZONING REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS, DECEMBER 12, 1984.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS.

SECTION I. That after receiving a recommendation from the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, and after said Planning Commission has given proper notice and held a public hearing as provided by law, and under authority granted by Section 17.C of the Zoning Regulations, the zoning district of the lands legally described is hereby changed as follows:

CASE NO. SCZ-0593

Zone Change from the "R" Rural Residential District to the "F" Heavy Industrial District

The north 1,095 feet of the east 465 feet of the NE 1/4 of Section 5, Township 26 South, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M., Sedgwick County, Kansas; EXCEPT the north 30 feet thereof; and EXCEPT Highway right-of-way taken in Condemnation Case CC-92066. Generally located at the southwest corner of 77th Street North and Broadway.

SECTION II. That upon the taking effect of this Resolution, the notation of such zone change shall be entered in the official zoning atlas on file in the Office of the County Zoning Administrator and in the Office of the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Commission.

SECTION III. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official county paper.
