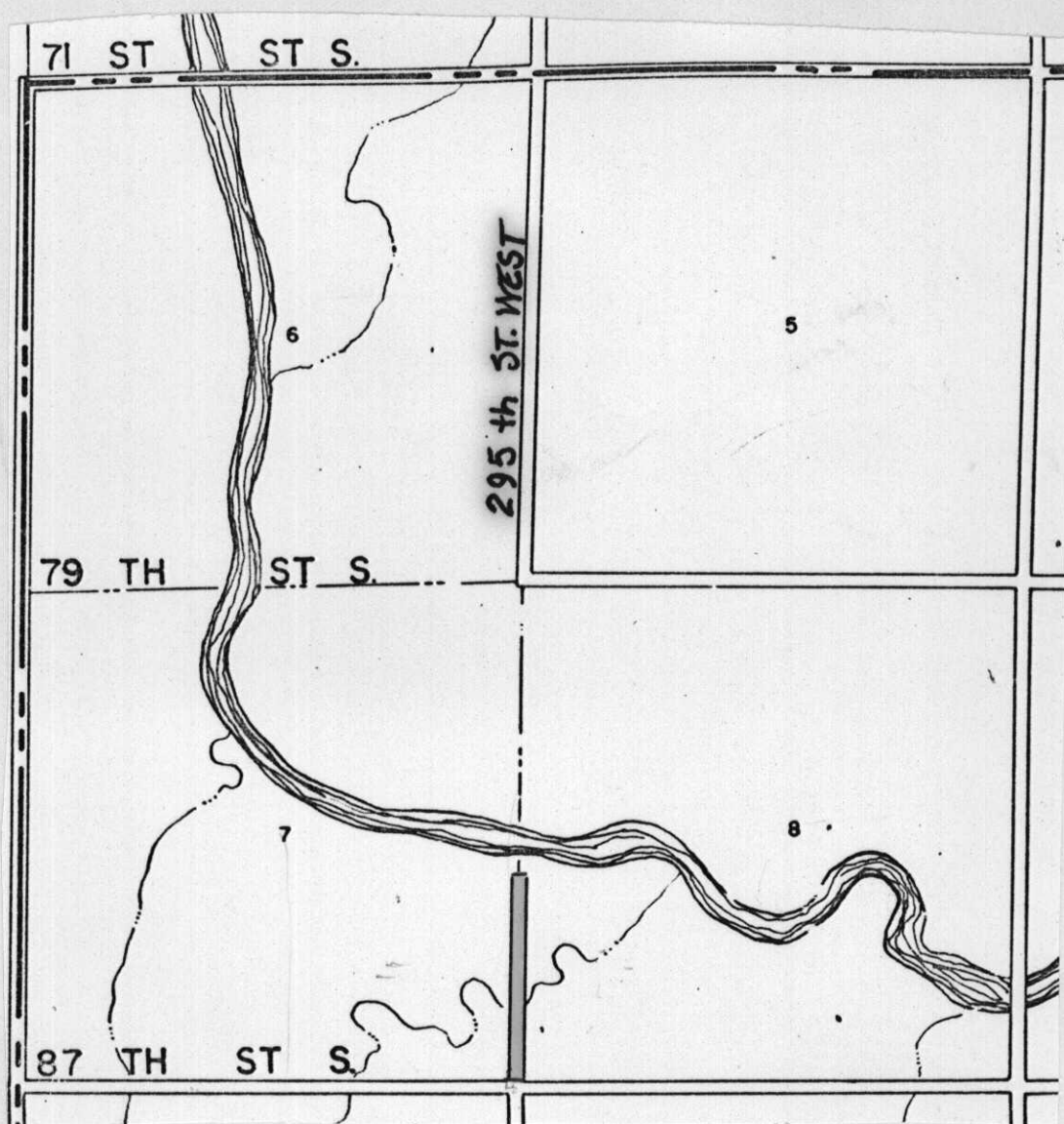

WHEREUPON, it is shown that proper notice has been given by
publication in the _____, a newspaper printed in

in Sedgwick County, Kansas, the first publication being made on the
