AND NORTH OF 13TH STREET NORTH. (District #5)

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement. (unanimous)

Background: This vacation has been requested in order to permit the installation of a sign for a restaurant that is being constructed on the subject lot. The City Engineer's Office and the Utility Advisory Committee has verified that the portion of easement being vacated is not needed for existing or planned utilities. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

VACATION ORDER

NOW on this 21st day of June, 1988, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by S.P. Allen's Partnership, praying for the vacation of the following described portion of a platted utility easement, to-wit:

The south 10 feet of Lot 2, Block 1, Northwest Village,
Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas, except the east 15 feet
and the west 10 feet thereof. (V-1537)

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Record of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on JUNE 8 & 15, 1988.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described utility easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.

3. In justice to the petitioner(s) the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the utility easement described herein should be approved.

IT IS, THEREFORE, BY THE CITY COUNCIL, on this 21st day of June, 1988, ordered that the above-described utility easement is hereby vacated. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk shall certify a copy of this order to the Register of Deeds of Sedgwick County.
