SUBJECT: V-1514 - REQUEST TO VACATE ACCESS CONTROL TO 37TH STREET
NORTH, LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF 37TH STREET NORTH,
IN AN AREA EAST OF ROCK ROAD. (District #2)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of access control.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of access control. (unanimous)

Background: This vacation case proposes the vacation of the "complete access control" platted to 37th Street North across the south line of the subject property. It is requested in conjunction with construction of a Southwestern Bell Telephone switching facility. If approved, the owner will be able to construct one driveway to serve the site. The Vacation Order retains "access control except for one opening". The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing; approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by
any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. "Access control except for one opening" is hereby retained.
6. The vacation of the access control described herein should be approved.
