SETBACK IN AN AREA ON THE NORTH SIDE OF REFLECTION ROAD ON
BOTH SIDES OF MORNING DEW.

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.
(unanimous)

Background: The 20-foot rear yard setbacks were platted in excess of what is established in the Reflection Ridge Residential Community Unit Plan, DP-170; which provides for 10-foot rear yard building setbacks when adjacent to open space; thus the platted rear yard building setbacks are not needed. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Record of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on JUN 28 1989 & JUL 5 1989.
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described platted building setback, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. Rear yard building setbacks shall be as provided in the Reflection Ridge Residential Community Unit Plan, DP-170; on file at the Metropolitan Area Planning Department.
6. The vacation of the platted building setback described herein should be approved.
