Background: This vacation is requested in order to permit an opening to Turnpike Drive so as to provide access to a property prior to submitting a lot split. The Vacation Order is retaining access control except for one opening to Turnpike Drive. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described platted utility easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. Access control except for one opening to Turnpike Drive shall be retained.
6. The vacation of the access control described herein should be approved.
