PLATTED BUILDING SETBACK ON THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF 17TH
STREET NORTH AND AMARADO
(District #5)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.
(unanimous)

Background: The configuration of this lot and its location on a corner has limited the buildable area of the lot. In order to build a proposed swimming pool on this lot, the applicant is requesting the reduction of the sideyard building setback. The applicant has submitted a restrictive covenant stating that development of the vacated portion of the setback is limited to construction of an unenclosed swimming pool. This case is associated with V-1601. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order and restrictive covenant, recording costs to be billed to:

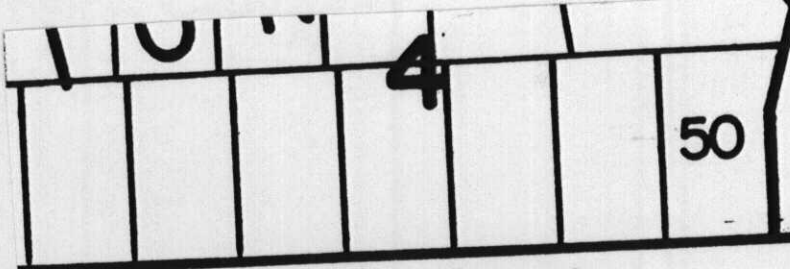

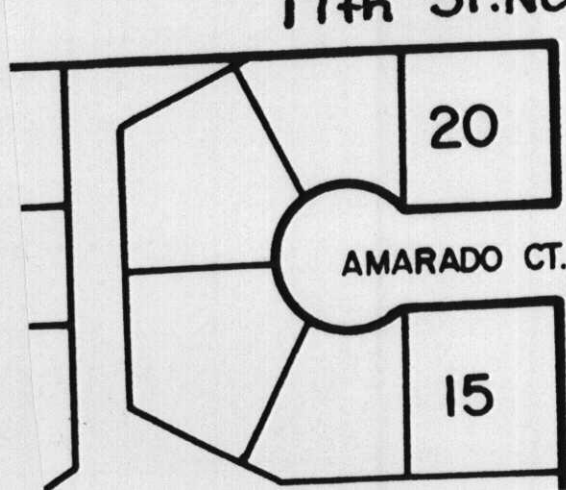

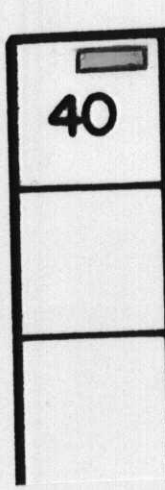
