Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.
(unanimous)

Background: In order to build across a common lot line the applicant has requested to vacate the easement along the common lot line. City Engineering has indicated that no City utilities are involved. However, a substitute easement was requested by representatives of the utility advisory subcommittee. The applicant has submitted the requested substitute easement. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Accept the substitute utility easement(s); close public hearing, approve the vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order and utility easements; recording costs to be billed to:

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the utility easement described herein should be approved.

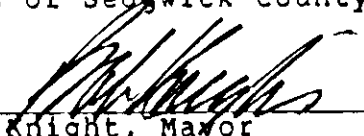
