EAST OF MAIZE ROAD.

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.
(unanimous)

Background: An existing garage was found to have a minor encroachment into a setback platted form an adjacent cul-de-sac rather than the street itself. The vacation is needed to clear the property's title. The Subdivision and Utility Advisory Committee have indicated that the vacation will have no adverse effects. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

NOW on this 5th day of November, 1991, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by Wayne Wehking, praying for the vacation of the following described building setback, to-wit:

That part of Lot 47, Westwind 2nd Addition, Wichita, Kansas, described as commencing at the northwest corner of said Lot 47; thence S00°02'E, along the west line of said Lot 47, 25.5 feet; thence N89°58'E, 4.9 feet for a point of beginning; thence continuing N89°58' E. 5.89 feet to a point on the platted 25 foot building setback line; thence southwesterly along the said 25 foot building setback line, 7.75 feet; thence N00°02'W, 5.02 feet to the point of beginning. The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Reporter of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on 10/22/91 & 10/29/91.

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described building setback, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.

3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The vacation of the building setback described herein should be approved.
