5. The vacation of the drainage easement described herein should be approved.

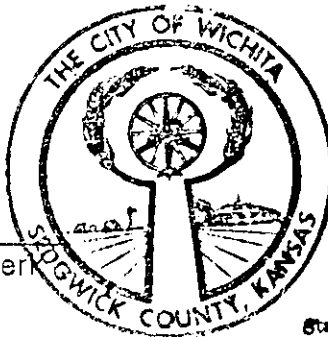

Sedgwick County.

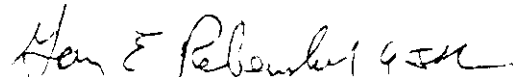
