Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

Both City Engineering and the utility representatives of the Subdivision Committee indicate that no facilities are located in the easement and no apparent future need exists for the easement. 2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described utility easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The vacation of the utility easement described herein should be approved.
