SUBJECT: VAC2003-00040 REQUEST TO VACATE EASEMENT DEDICATED BY SEPARATE INSTRUMENT LOCATED SOUTHWEST OF THE WEST STREET – 3RD STREET INTERSECTION.
(District IV)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department JLS

AGENDA: Planning (Consent)

Staff Recommendation: Approve.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve. (unanimous)

Background: The applicant is requesting vacation of the east 5-foot of the 16-foot easement that was dedicated by separate instrument. The dedication is recorded in Book 456, Page 341, with the Register of Deeds. The Park Wilde Addition was recorded with the Register of Deeds 03-04-1887.

Analysis: An existing garage and an existing house encroach into the easement. To clear the title for the sale the property, these encroachments must be removed. There is sewer in the easement. Existing structures west of the easement prevent dedication to equal a 20-foot easement, which is the current minimum width for Public Works' easements. Dedication of 5-feet to the west side of the easement will allow the easement to remain 16-feet.

No one spoke in opposition to this request at the MAPC's advertised public hearing, and the MAPC voted to approve the vacation, adopting the findings of fact that are incorporated in the Vacation Order. No written protests have been filed.

Financial Considerations: None

Legal Considerations: A certified copy of the Vacation Order will be recorded with the Register of Deeds and dedication, by separate instrument, of 5-feet to the west side of easement as recorded in Book 456, Page 341, with the Register of Deeds.

Recommendation/Actions: Follow the recommendation of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission and approve the Vacation Order, and authorize the necessary signatures.
