

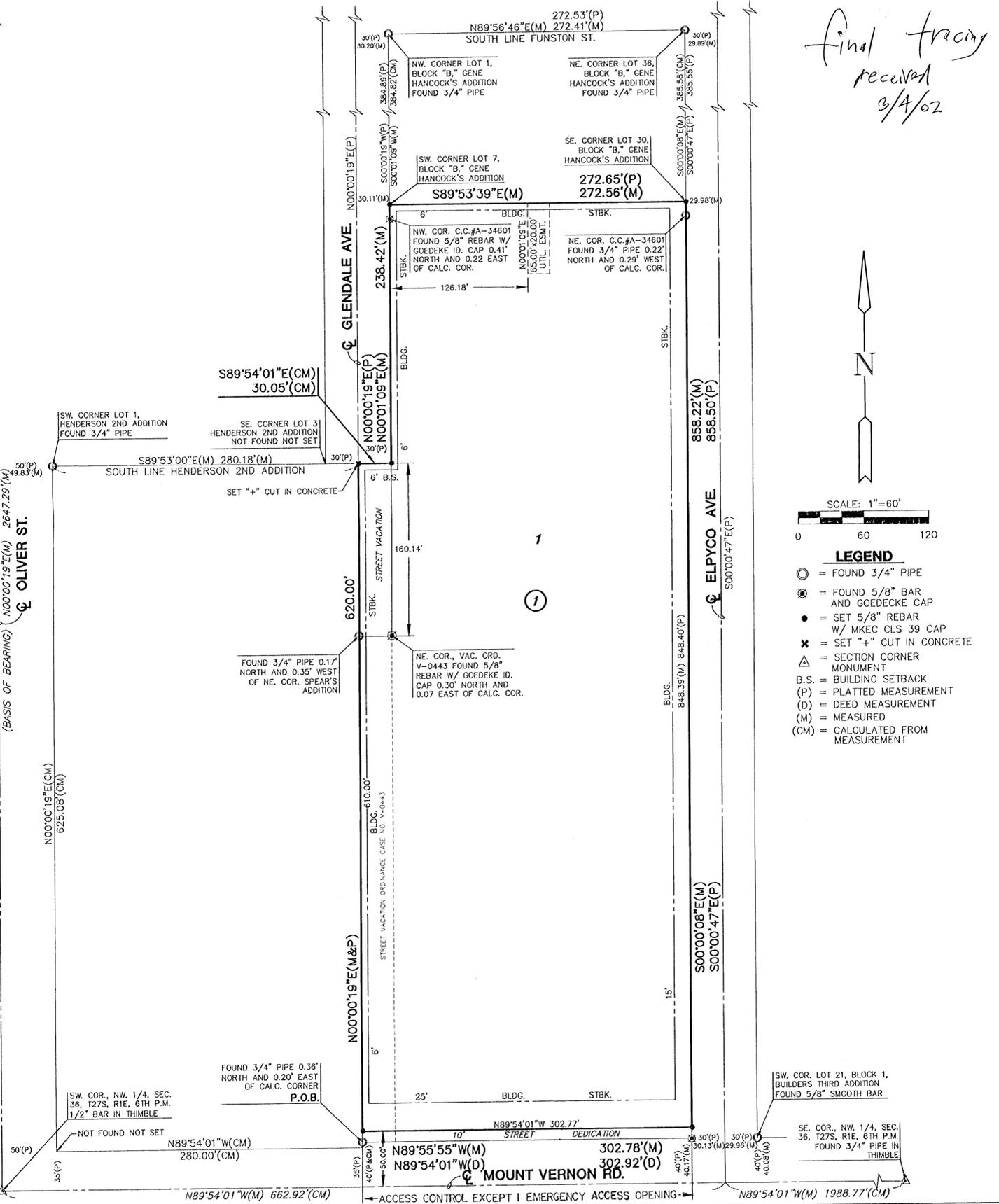

Beginning at a point lying 40.00 feet North and 330.00 feet East of the Southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter, said point lying on the North right-of-way line of Mount Vernon Road; thence along the centerline of vacated Glendale Avenue and parallel with the West line of said Northwest Quarter N00°00'19"E, 620.00 feet to a point 30.00' feet East of the Southeast corner of Henderson 2nd Addition, an addition to Wichita, Kansas; thence S89°54'01"E, 30.05 feet to the East right-of-way line of Glendale Avenue; thence along said East line N00°01'09"E, 238.42 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 7, Block "B," Gene Hancock's Addition; thence along the South lines of said Lots 7 and 30, of said Block "B," S89°53'39"E, 272.56 feet to a point lying on the West right-of-way line of Elpyco Avenue as platted in Gene Hancock's Addition, said point also being the Southeast corner of said Lot 30; thence along said West line S00°0'08"E, 858.22 feet to a point on said North right-of-way line; thence along said North right-of-way line N89°55' 55"W, 302.78 feet to the point of beginning.

All lots, blocks, streets, utility easements, drainage easements, access control, within the above described property are hereby vacated and replatted by virtue of K.S.A. 12-512(b).

At the regular meeting of the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission on November 8, 2001, the above captioned plat was considered. The action of the Planning Commission was to approve the plat as recommended by the Subdivision Committee, subject to the conditions stated in our letter dated October 19, 2001.

In addition to complying with those conditions, it is necessary that you meet the following requirements before this plat can be forwarded to the City Council and/or County Commission for consideration:

1. Submission of the fully completed and signed tracing of the subdivision, along with four (4) copies, to the Metropolitan Area Planning Department.
2. Submission of a check, made out to the Register of Deeds, covering the costs of any documents to be recorded as a requirement of platting.
3. Subdivision regulations now require a detailed Lot Grading Plan be submitted to Engineering prior to the tracing being released. This applies to all multi-lot, residential developments.
4. Submission of a disk to the Planning Department detailing the final plat in digital format in Autocad. This will be used by the City and County GIS Departments.

- A. Municipal services are available to serve the site. **City Engineering** needs to comment on the need for guarantees or easements. The north-south utility easement extending from the north property line needs to be reduced.
- B. If improvements are guaranteed by petition, a notarized certificate listing the petitions shall be submitted to the Planning Department for recording.
- C. **City Engineering** needs to comment on the status of the applicant's drainage plan. The drainage plan is approved.
- D. **Traffic Engineering** needs to comment on the need for additional right-of-way for Mt. Vernon which is designated as an arterial. The plat's text shall note the dedication of the streets to and for the use of the public. The applicant shall dedicate an additional 10 feet of right-of-way.
- E. **Traffic Engineering** needs to comment on the access controls. The plat proposes two access openings along Mt. Vernon and an emergency access. Traffic Engineering and MAPD have recommended complete access control along Mt Vernon Road, with the exception of an emergency access opening.
- F. A guarantee shall be submitted assuring the construction of an all-weather roadway surface for the emergency access easement. The text of the instrument shall indicate the type of driving surface to be installed and address installation and maintenance. Standard gating and signing are required per County Fire Department standards.

- G. The applicant shall submit an avigational easement covering all of the subject plat and a restrictive covenant assuring that adequate construction methods will be used to minimize the effects of noise pollution in the habitable structures constructed on subject property.
- H. On the final plat, the MAPC signature block needs to reference "J.D. Michaelis, Chair".
- I. Approval of this plat will require a waiver of the lot depth to width ratio of the Subdivision Regulations. The Subdivision Regulations state that the maximum depth of all residential lots shall not exceed 2.5 times the width. **A modification has been approved by the Subdivision Committee.**
- J. If determined to be part of the Glendale right-of-way, the Applicant shall contact the adjoining property owner to the west regarding the proposed vacation of right-of-way for Glendale Avenue. A vacation case shall be approved before the approval of the plat. If no off-site right-of-way for Glendale exists, the portion of Glendale as depicted within the site may be vacated through the plat. The applicant shall dedicate additional right-of-way to obtain a 30-ft wide "L"-type turnaround for Glendale Avenue.
- K. The Applicant is reminded that a platting binder is required with the final plat. Approval of this plat will be subject to submittal of this binder and any relevant conditions found by such a review.
- L. The platator's text shall include language that a drainage plan has been developed for the plat and that all drainage easements, rights-of-way, or reserves shall remain at established grades or as modified with the approval of the applicable City or County Engineer, and unobstructed to allow for the conveyance of stormwater.

- U. The applicant is reminded that a disk shall be submitted with the final plat tracing to the Planning Department detailing this plat in digital format in AutoCAD. This will be used by the City and County GIS Department.

If this plat requires the guaranteeing of improvements, a list of the five methods which have been adopted as being acceptable is available through the Planning Department. Certificates, which are required if petitions are submitted, and forms for the bond and Irrevocable Letter of Credit are also available from this office.

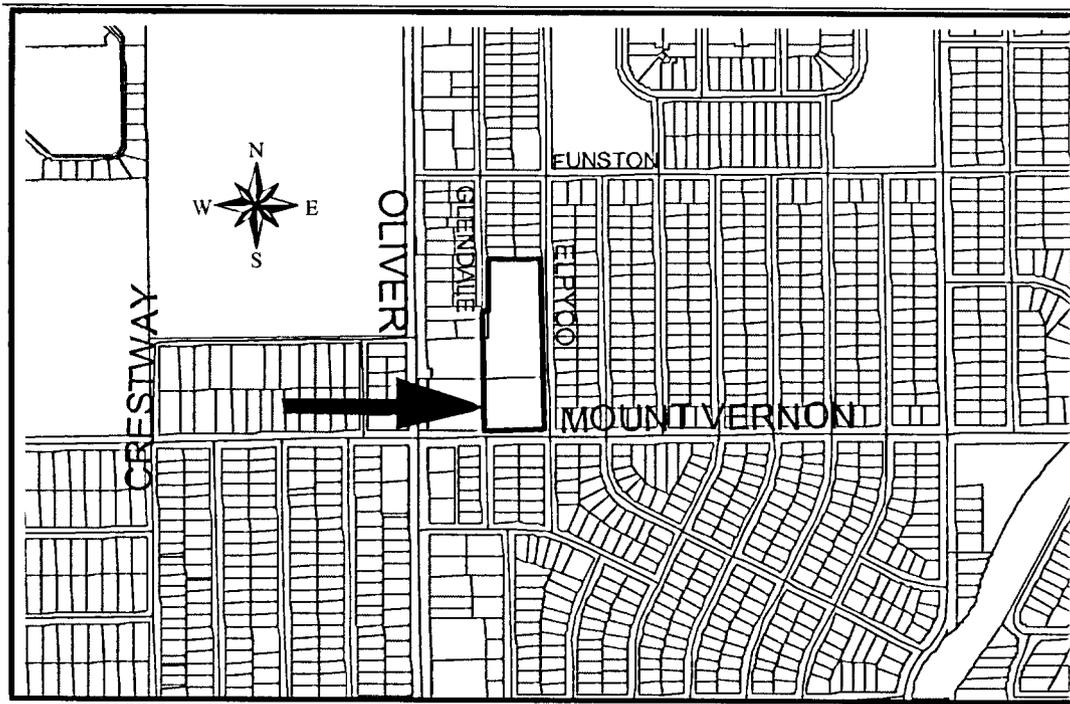
