

ORDINANCE NO. 26-232

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That it is hereby declared to be a public necessity and convenience to eliminate confusion in the names of the following named streets in the City of Wichita, Kansas, and the names of such streets should be and the same are hereby changed from and after the effective date of this ordinance and shall be known, named and designated by the new name as follows, to-wit:

BERNIE STREET as platted in Sunnybrook Second Addition changed to CAPRI LANE.

SHARON AVENUE as platted in Eastborough Fourth Addition from the east line of Cresthill Manor Addition to the west line of Armour Drive changed to ROCKWOOD ROAD.

SECTION 2: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.

ORDINANCE NO. 26-233

AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING AND INCORPORATING CERTAIN BLOCKS, PARCELS, PIECES AND TRACTS OF LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS AND RELATING THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following blocks, parcels, pieces and tracts of land be and they are hereby included and brought within the corporate limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas:

Unplatted tracts in the Southeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 27, South, Range 1 West of the 6th P.M. more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 16 four hundred fifty-nine and eighty-one hundredths (459.81) feet west of the southeast corner of said Southeast Quarter; thence north two hundred fifty (250) feet; thence west three hundred (300) feet to the east line of Country Acres Avenue; thence south along said east line a distance of two hundred fifty (250) feet to the south line of said Southeast Quarter; thence east three hundred (300) feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. That the lands specified and included in Section 1 of this ordinance, together with the lands specified and included within Section of of Ordinance Nos. 26-163, 26-169, 26-170, 26-171, 26-186, 26-187, 26-188, 26-189, 26-190, 26-195, 26-196, 26-197, 26-228, 26-229, 26-230, be and the same are hereby declared to constitute the lands within the corporate limits and boundaries of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

SECTION 3. That if any part or portion of this ordinance shall be held or determined to be illegal, ultra vires or void, the same shall not be held or construed to alter, change or annul any terms or provisions hereof which may be legal or lawful. And in the event this ordinance in its entirety shall be held to be ultra vires, illegal or void, then in such event the boundaries and limits of said city shall be held to be those heretofore established by law.

SECTION 4. That the City Attorney be and he is hereby instructed at the proper time to draw an ordinance re-defining the boundaries and limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas under and pursuant to G.S. 1961 Supp., 12-517 et seq.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.

ORDINANCE NO. 26-234

AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING AND INCORPORATING CERTAIN BLOCKS, PARCELS, PIECES AND TRACTS OF LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS AND RELATING THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following blocks, parcels, pieces and tracts of land be and they are hereby included and brought within the corporate limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas:

Tyler Acres First Addition, in the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, Township 27, South, Range 1, West of the 6th P.M., more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north line of the south half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 16, six hundred seven (607) feet west of the northeast corner of said south half; thence left at an angle of ninety (90) degrees a distance of three hundred (300) feet; thence right at an angle of ninety (90) degrees a distance of one hundred sixty and fifty-five hundredths (160.55) feet to the intersection of a curve having a delta of twelve (12) degrees ten (10) minutes fifty-two (52) seconds and a radius of one thousand six hundred twenty-one and seventy-eight hundredths (1621.78) feet; thence left eighty-six (86) degrees forty-two (42) minutes twenty-six (26) seconds and along said curve a distance of three hundred forty-four and eight-tenths (344.8) feet to a point of tangent of said curve; thence continuing in a straight line along said tangent a distance of thirty (30) feet; thence right at an
