

ORDINANCE NO. 26-957

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF SUBMAIN 12, WAR INDUSTRIES SEWER, IN THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, by resolution duly adopted on the 11th day of November, 1962, the City Engineer of the City of Wichita was authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of a sanitary sewer more particularly described as follows:

Submain 12, War Industries Sewer,

and cause an estimate of the cost to be filed with the City Clerk for the construction of said sewer; and,

WHEREAS, such plans, specifications and estimate of cost have been filed with the City Clerk as provided for by resolution:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That it is hereby declared to be a public necessity to construct Submain 12, War Industries Sewer, in the City of Wichita.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor by and with the consent of the Board of Commissioners shall appoint three disinterested appraisers, who shall proceed to appraise such lots and pieces of land as shall be liable for said special improvements, being all of the lots and pieces of land in said sewer benefit district as described by Ordinance No. 26-839 and that the said appraiser shall be returned to this Commission at their first meeting after the same has been completed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official City paper.

ORDINANCE NO. 26-958

AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING AND INCORPORATING CERTAIN PLOCCS, PARCELS, PIECES AND TRACTS OF LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS AND RELATING THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following blocks, parcels, pieces and tracts of land be and they are hereby included and brought within the corporate limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas:

Unplatted tracts in the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 26 South, Range 1 East of the 6th T. M., and adjacent Railroad right-of-way, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east right-of-way line of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad thirty-five (35) feet north of the south line of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28; thence east parallel to said south line to the east right-of-way line of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad; thence north along said right-of-way line to the southerly right-of-way line of the Chisholm Creek Diversion; thence southwesterly along said right-of-way line to the east right-of-way line of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad, thence south to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. That the lands specified and included in Section 1 of this ordinance, together with the lands specified and included within Section 1 of Ordinance Nos. 26-918, 16-919, 26-920, 26-925, 26-926, 26-927, 26-929, 26-930, 26-934, 26-935, 26-936, 26-937, 26-943, 26-944, 26-945, 26-950, 26-951, 26-952, 26-953, 26-954, 26-955, be and the same are hereby declared to constitute the lands within the corporate limits and boundaries of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

SECTION 3. That if any part or portion of this ordinance shall be held or determined to be illegal, ultra vires, or void, the same shall not be held or construed to alter, change or annul any terms or provisions hereof which may be legal or lawful. And in the event this ordinance in its entirety shall be held to be ultra vires, illegal or void, then in such event the boundaries and limits of said city shall be held to be those heretofore established by law.

SECTION 4. That the City Attorney be and he is hereby instructed at the proper time to draw an ordinance re-defining the boundaries and limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas under and pursuant to G.S. 1961 Supp., 12-517 et seq.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.

ORDINANCE NO. 26-959

AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING AND INCORPORATING CERTAIN BLOCKS, PARCELS, PIECES AND TRACTS OF LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, AND RELATING THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following blocks, parcels, pieces and tracts of land be and they are hereby included and incorporated within the corporate limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas:

Wellbink Heights, in the Southeast Quarter of Section 28, Township 22 South, Range 1 West of Meridian P.M., more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of the Southeast Quarter of Section 28 one and one-half (1 1/2) feet east of the southwest corner of said Southeast Quarter; thence north parallel to the west line of said Southeast Quarter a distance of one hundred and hundred thirty (1130) feet to the point of curvature of a curve to the
