ORDINANCE NO. 26-992

AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING AND INCORPORATING CERTAIN BLOCKS, PARCELS, PIECES AND TRACTS OF LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS AND RELATING THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following blocks, parcels, pieces and tracts of land be and they are hereby included and brought within the corporate limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas:

Vacated Blocks A and B, Edwards Gardens, in the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 26 South, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M., more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south line of the north twelve and sixty-five hundredths (12.65) acres of Government Lot 5, Section 29, three hundred forty-three and five-tenths (343.5) feet west of the east line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section 29, said point being on the center line of the abandoned right-of-way of the Arkansas Valley Interurban Railway Company; thence southeasterly along said center line a distance of four hundred ninety (490) feet to the point of curvature of a four (4) degree fifty-nine and five-tenths (59.5) minute curve to the right; thence along said curve a distance of three hundred seventeen (317) feet; thence east at ninety (90) degrees to the east line of said Northwest Quarter a distance of thirty (30) feet to said east line; thence south along said east line to a point one hundred one and forty-six hundredths (101.46) feet south of the northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of said Northwest Quarter; thence west at ninety (90) degrees to said east line a distance of seven hundred thirty-one and one-tenth (731.1) feet to the point of curvature of a curve to the right having a radius of fifty (50) feet; thence along said curve a distance of seventy-seven and five-tenths (77.5) feet, more or less, to the point of tangent of said curve; thence north a distance of seven hundred ten (710) feet to the south line of the north twelve and sixty-five hundredths (12.65) acres of Government Lot 5; thence east a distance of four hundred thirty-eight (438) feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. Lots 3 through 14, J. B. Muller Addition, in the Northeast Quarter of Section 29, Township 26 South, Range 1 East of the 6th P. M., more fully described as follows:
