ORDINANCE NO. 25-910

AN ORDINANCE INCLUDING AND INCORPORATING CERTAIN TRACTS, BLOCKS, PARCELS, AND PIECES OF LAND WITHIN THE LIMITS AND BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS AND RELATING THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following blocks, parcels, pieces and tracts of land be and they are hereby included and brought within the corporate limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas;

- A. Unplatted tracts in the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 27 South, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M. and U.S. 54 right-of-way adjacent to the above unplatted tracts, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the north line of U.S. 54 right-of-way and the east line of Webb Road; thence south along the east line of Webb Road to the south line of the Kansas Turnpike; thence east along said right-of-way line to the east line of the west half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 28, Township 27 South, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M.; thence north along said line to the north line of U.S. 54; thence west to the point of beginning.

- B. Unplatted tracts in the west half of Section 7, Township 27 South, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M., more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the east line of Woodlawn Boulevard and the south line of the St. Louis and San Francisco Railroad right-of-way; thence east along said right-of-way to the east line of government Lot 2 in the Northwest Quarter of Section 7, Township 27 South, Range 2 East of the 6th P.M., extended from the north; thence north along the east line of said government Lot 2 to a point 1,017 feet north of the Southeast corner of said government Lot 2; thence west along a line parallel to and 1,017' north of the south line of said government Lot 2 to the east line of Woodlawn Boulevard; thence south to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. That the lands specified and included in Section 1 of this ordinance, together with the lands specified and included within Section 1 of Ordinance Nos. 25-663, 25-678, 25-833, 25-878 and 25-893 be and the same are hereby declared to constitute the lands within the corporate limits and boundaries of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

SECTION 3. That if any part or portion of this ordinance shall be held or determined to be illegal, ultra vires or void, the same shall not be held or construed to alter, change or annul any terms or provisions hereof which may be legal or lawful.

And in the event this ordinance in its entirety shall be held to be ultra vires, illegal, or void, then in such event the boundaries and limits of said city shall be held to be those heretofore established by law.

SECTION 4. That the City Attorney be and he is hereby instructed at the proper time to draw an ordinance re-defining the boundaries and limits of the City of Wichita, Kansas under and pursuant to G.S. 1959 Supp., 12-517 et seq.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.

ORDINANCE NO. 25-911

AN ORDINANCE MAKING A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT TO PAY FOR THE COST OF ABATING CERTAIN PUBLIC HEALTH NUISANCES UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7.40.020 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WICHITA:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the sums set opposite the following lots, pieces and parcels of land or ground, herein specified, be and the same are hereby levied to pay the cost of abating certain public health nuisances under the provisions of Section 7.40.020 of the Code of the City of Wichita, which public health nuisances were determined to have existed upon the following described property:

SECTION 2. The sum so assessed and apportioned against the several lots, pieces and parcels of land as hereinbefore set out and not paid within 30 days from date of notices sent out by the City Clerk as provided by law, shall be collected by special assessment upon the property liable therefore in one installment and placed upon the tax roll for the year 1961 and shall be certified to the County Clerk and shall be levied and collected in the same manner as other taxes, and the City Clerk is hereby directed to give written notice to property owners owning property assessed therein, as required by law.
