DEVELOPMENT GUIDELINES

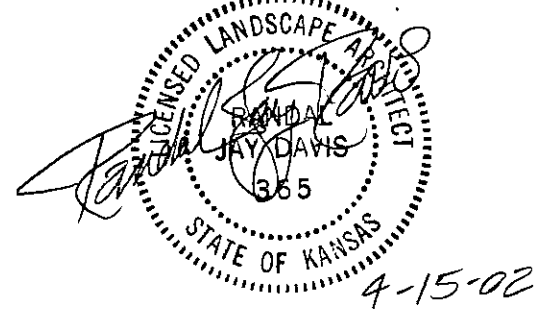
General Provisions

- This development is proposed to contain 72.58 gross acres and 72.58 net more or less. There are no internal public street areas.
- Setbacks are as indicated on plan view; if not shown shall per Property Development standards for the L.C. Zoning District.
- All utilities shall be installed underground.
- Signs: Shall be as permitted by L.C. Zoning District in accordance with the provisions of section 28.04.139 of the code of the City of Wichita, except that no portable, offsite, rotating signs, or flashing lights shall be permitted. Sign height shall be limited to a maximum height of 20' except for a 35-foot tall major development identification sign located in the southeastern corner of Parcel 1C. Signage for Parcels 3C & 1B may be placed upon one of the parcels with direct frontage on Meridian Ave., however, all signs shall be spaced a minimum of 150 feet apart regardless of lot configuration, leasing, or ownership.
Maximum sign areas shall be limited as follows:
Parcel 1A: 125 square feet;
Parcel 1B: 125 square feet
Parcel 1C: 152 square feet
Parcel 2: 125 square feet
Parcels 3A, 3B, and 3C shall share a total of 160 square feet.
Parcel 4A-1 shall be permitted 250 square feet of signage on Parcel 4B along Meridian Avenue.
Parcel 4B shall be permitted a total of 330 square foot of monument signage along Meridian Avenue provided it is spaced 100 feet north of Parcel 4A-1 signage.
It is permitted that the total sign area totaling above exceeds 0.8 times the frontage of Meridian Avenue by 24 square feet.
Parcel 4A-1 is allowed a single building sign on the southern building facade of the "Farha Sports Center" (the westernmost building on this Parcel) that shall not exceed 825 square feet in area. Said building sign may be backlit or illuminated from the ground.
- Architectural Language: All building exteriors in Parcels 1A, 1C, 2, 3A, 3B, 3C and 4B shall share a uniform architectural character, color, texture, and the same predominate exterior building material. Parcels 1B and 4A-1 shall share a uniform architectural character, color, texture, and the same predominate exterior building material. Building walls and roofs must have predominately earth-tone colors, with vivid colors limited to incidental accent.
- Drainage: All drainage ways and easements shall be determined at the time of platting. A lot grading plan will be prepared in conformance with the general drainage concept plan for review prior to the issuance of a building permit.
- Final determination of street right-of-way and pavement widths on public / private streets shall be resolved at the time of platting.
- There shall be complete access control along the south side of 33rd Street west of Gordon Street except for emergency access, which shall be determined at the time of platting.
- All undeveloped areas are to be planted with ground cover to minimize blowing of dust and dirt from the site.
- Outdoor lights located in the north 300 feet of Parcel 4A-1 and 4B must be directed away from residential areas located north of 33rd Street; and all outdoor recreational activities must cease and outdoor lighting be turned off by 10:00 P.M.
- Parcel 4A-1 shall be developed substantially in compliance with the site plan labeled "Wichita YMCA New South Branch" submitted as part of this application.
- The development of this property shall proceed in accordance with the development plan as recommended for approval by the Planning Commission and approved by the Governing Body, and any substantial deviation of the plan, as determined by the Zoning Administrator and the Director of Planning, shall constitute a violation of the building permit authorizing construction of the proposed development.
- Any major changes in this development plan shall be submitted to the Planning Commission and to the Governing Body for their consideration.
- The transfer of title of all or any portion of the land included within the Community Unit Plan does not constitute a termination of the plan or any portion thereof, but said plan shall run with the land for commercial development and be binding upon the present owners, their successors and assigns, unless amended.
- Parking: Given the unique nature of the activities thereon parking requirements for Parcel 4A-1 shall be as deemed necessary for the functional use by the owner/operator.

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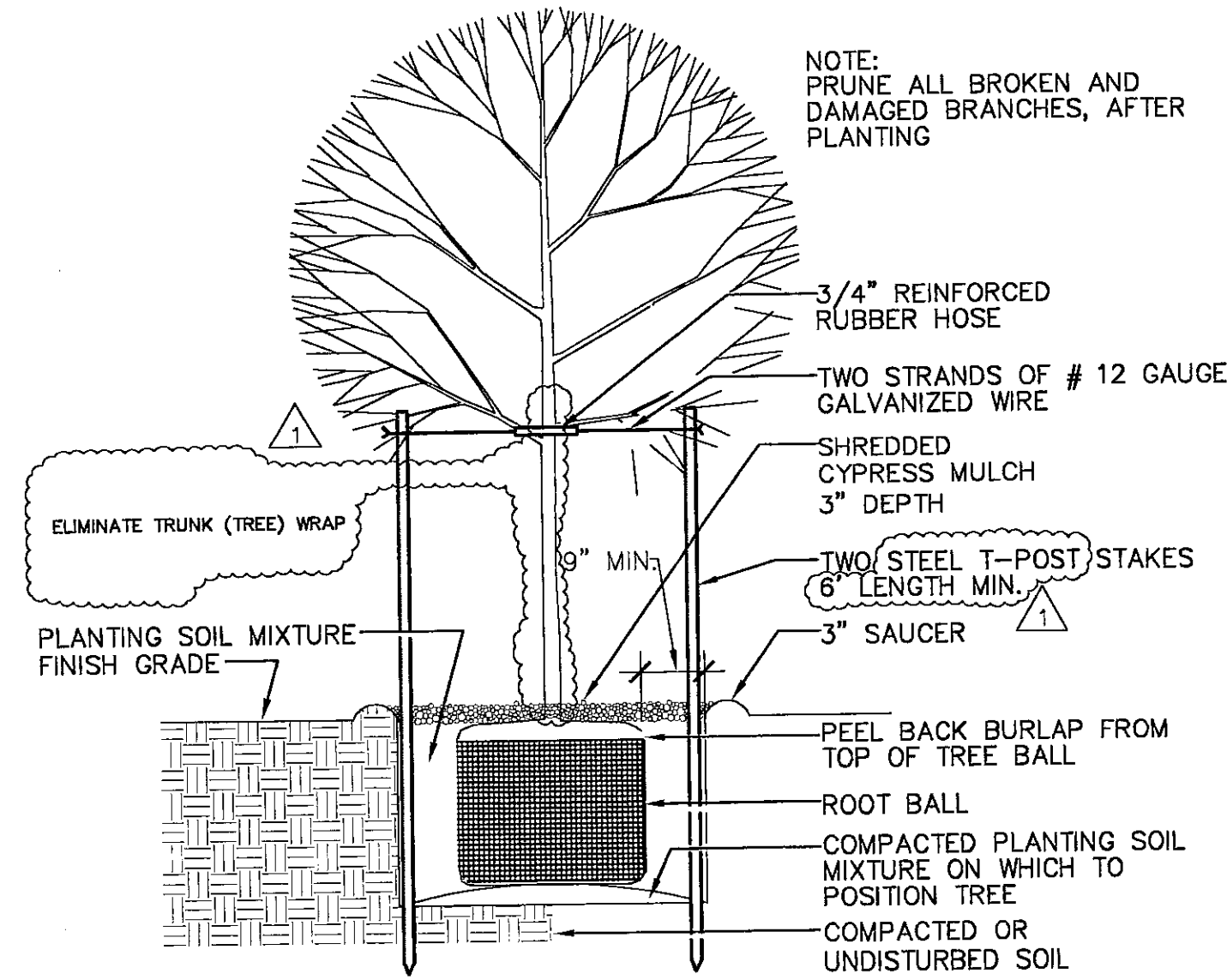

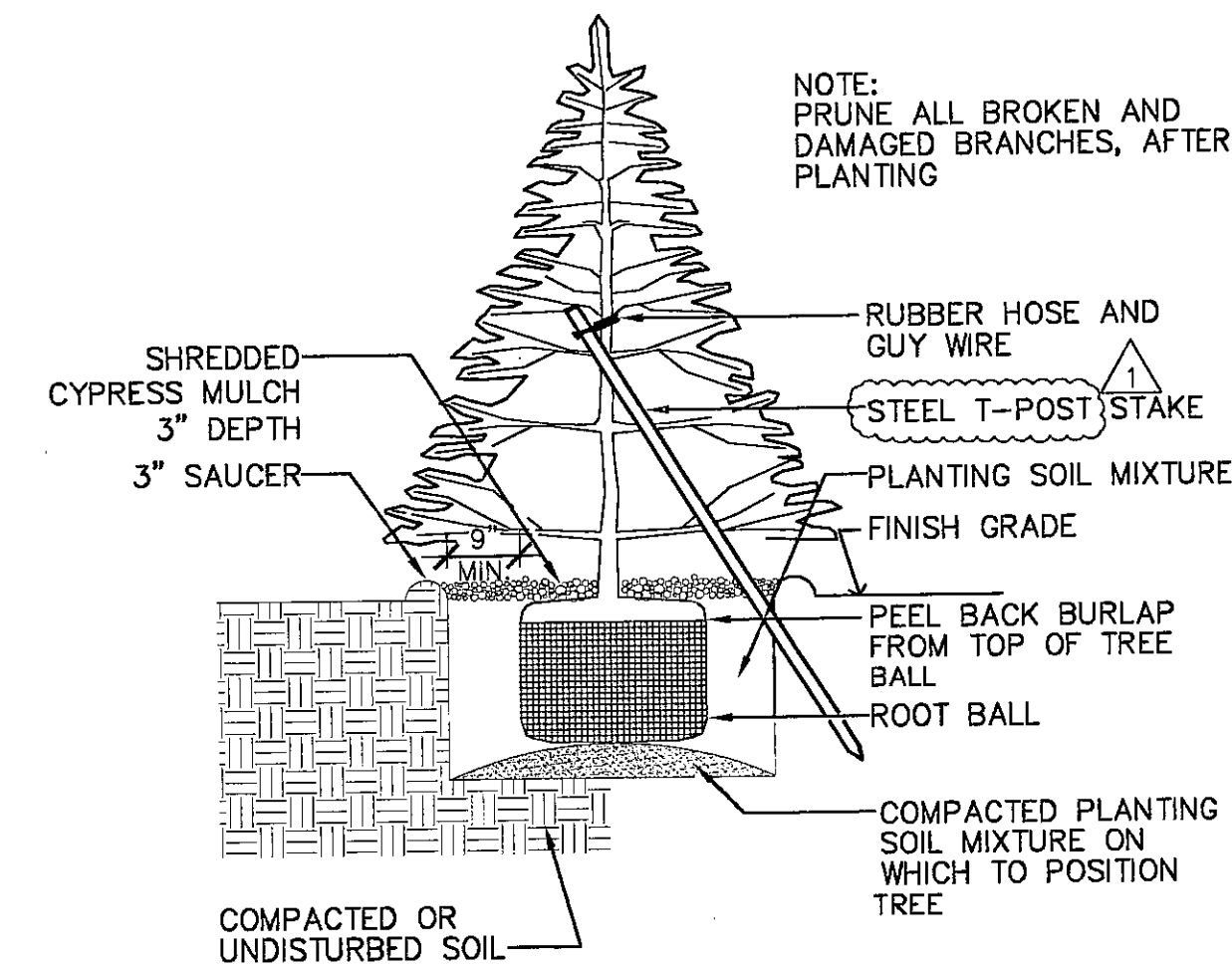

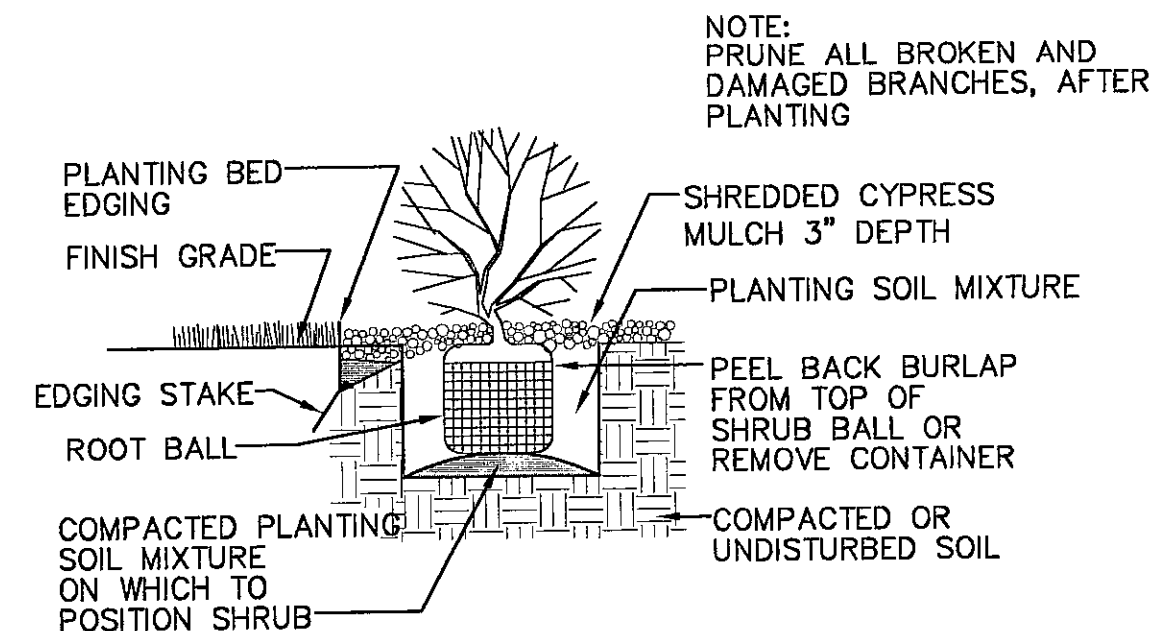

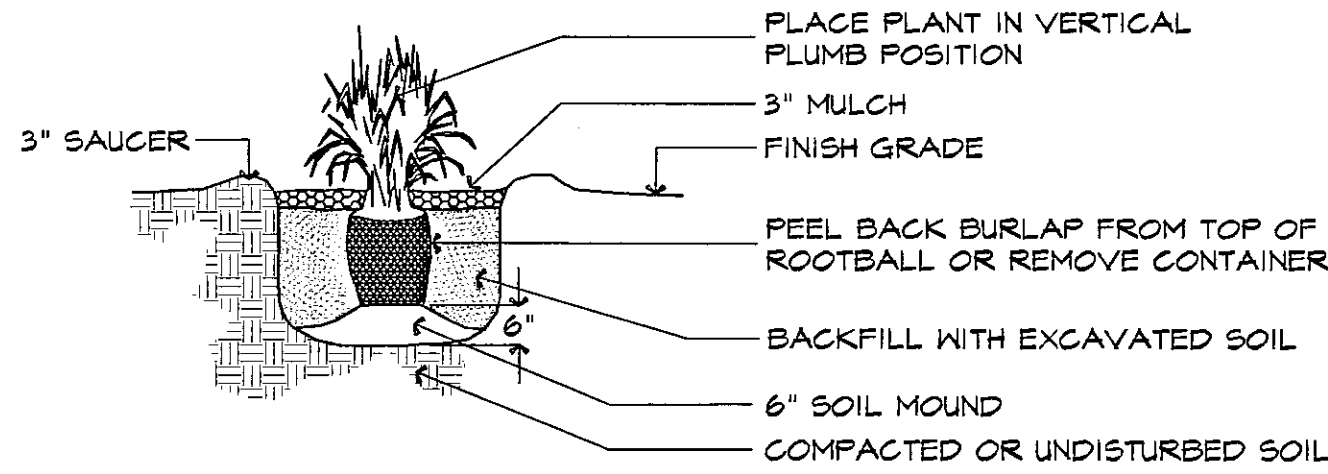

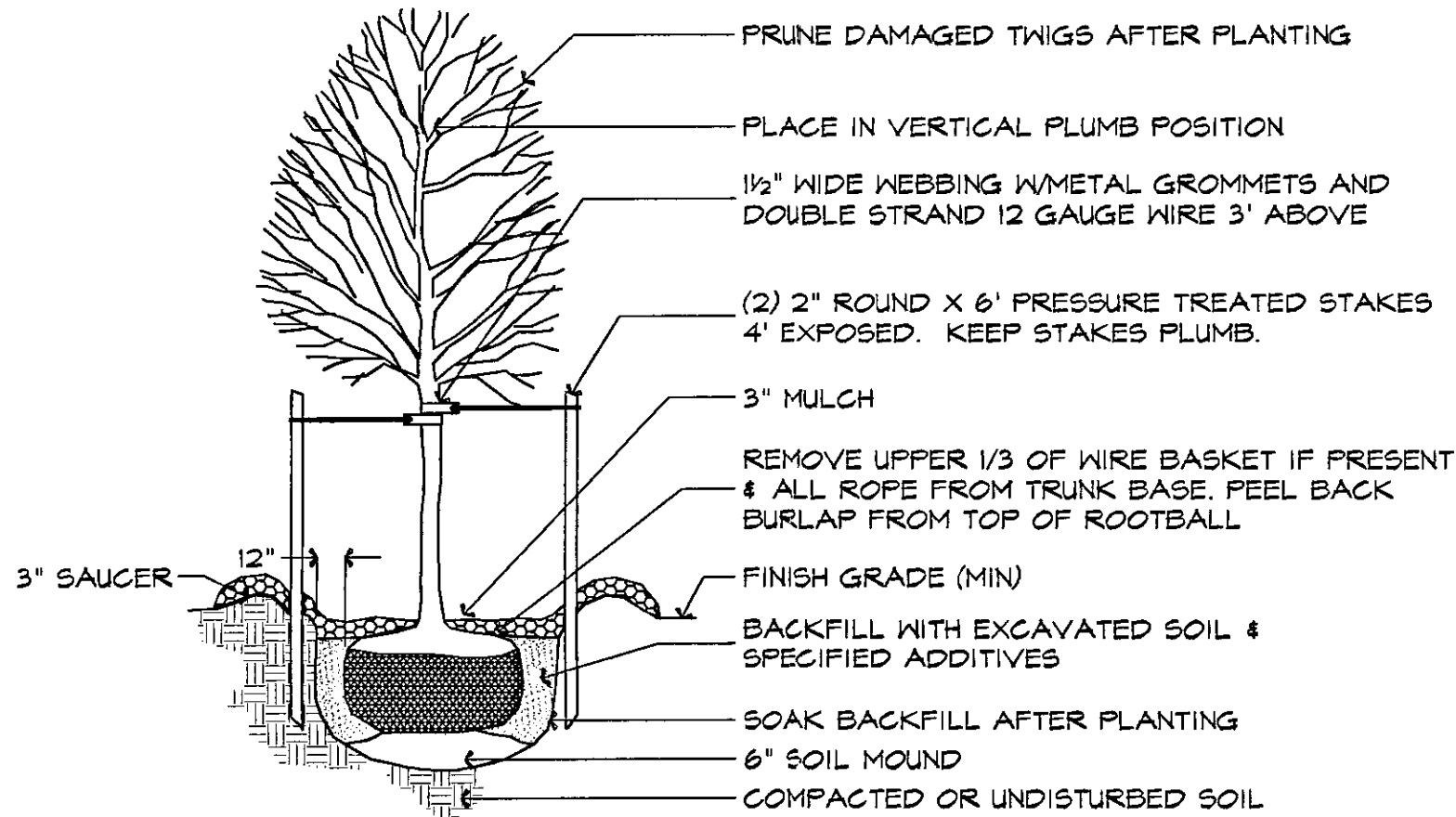


SHRUB PLANTING DETAIL

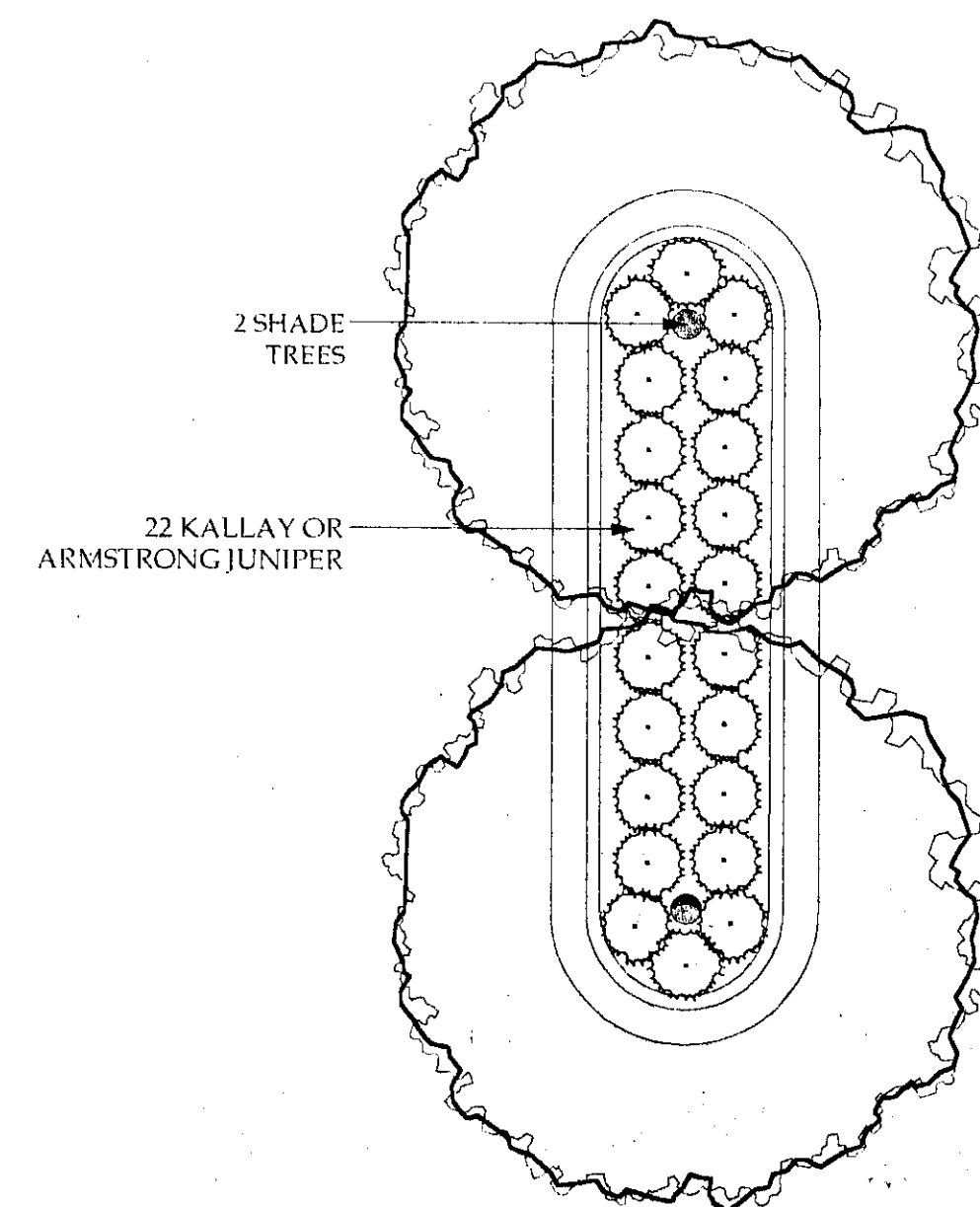


Site Landscape Plan - Sheet 1 YMCA South Branch

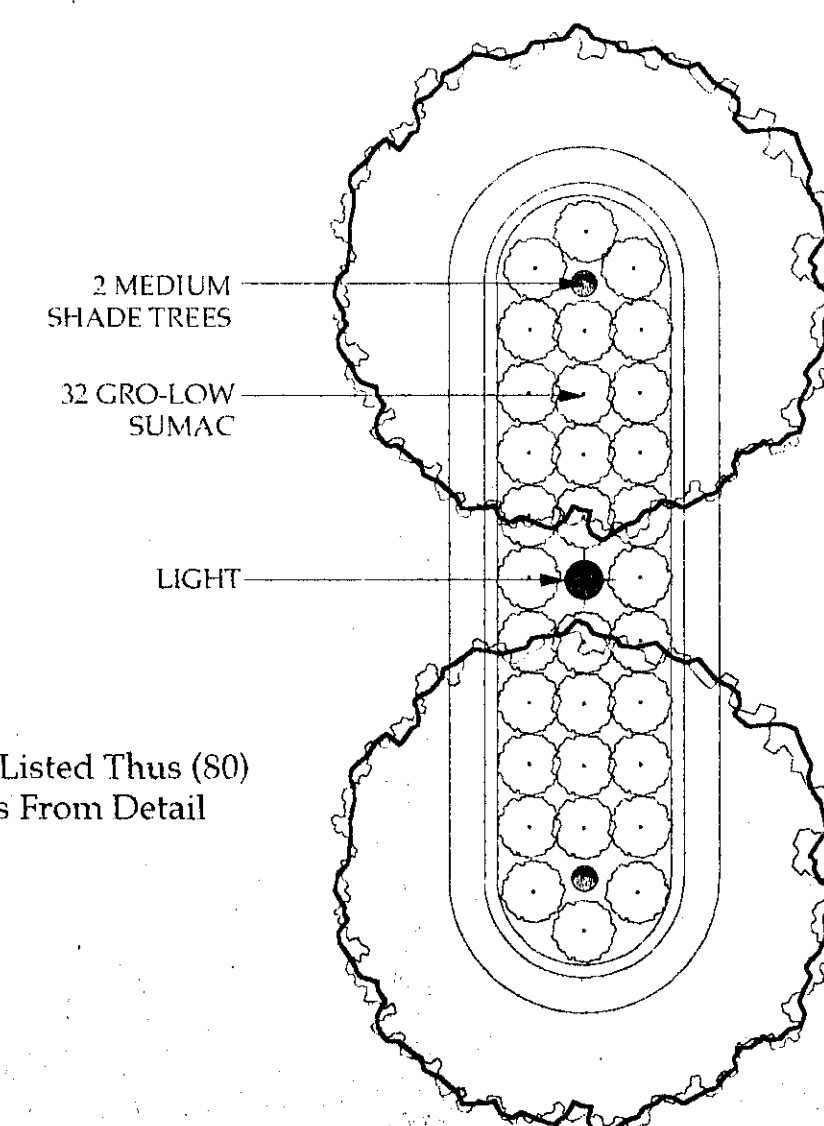

Address:	3405 S. Meridian
Adjacent Zoning:	Adjacent zoning to the south, west and north is Single Family Residential. Adjacent zoning to the east is Single Family and Two Family Residential.
Street Classifications:	33rd Street South is classified as a Local Street. Meridian is classified as an Arterial. I-235 is classified as an Expressway.
Required Landscape Area:	Due to large area of site and building location, required landscaping shall be as directed and approved by the City.
Planned Landscape Area:	The site is about 70 acres of which about 52 acres is landscape area.
Required Street Yard Trees:	Due to large area of site and building location, required street yard trees shall be as directed and approved by the City.
Existing Street Yard Trees:	Existing hedge row trees to northeast of site are in fair to good condition and provide moderate to dense screening.

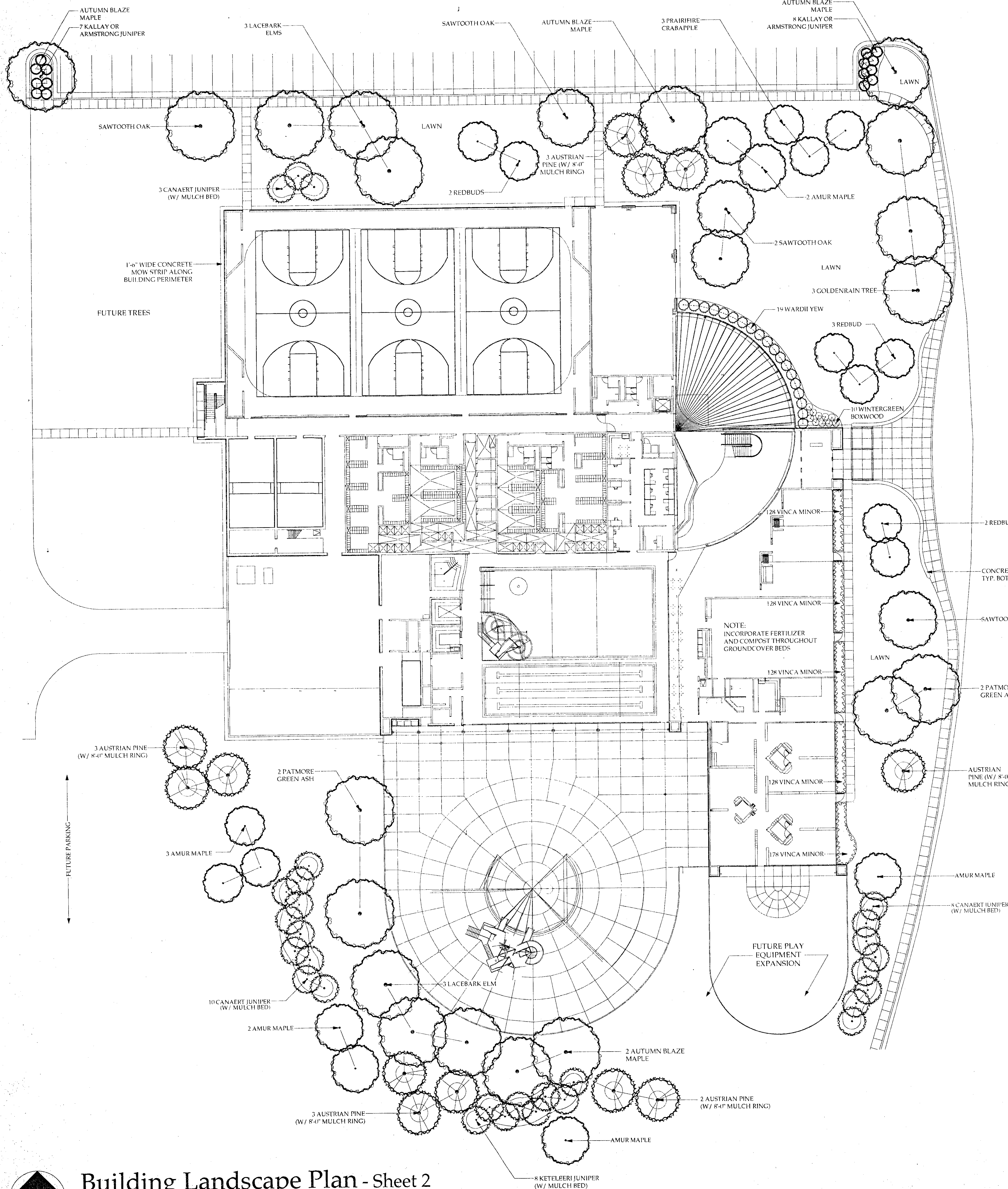

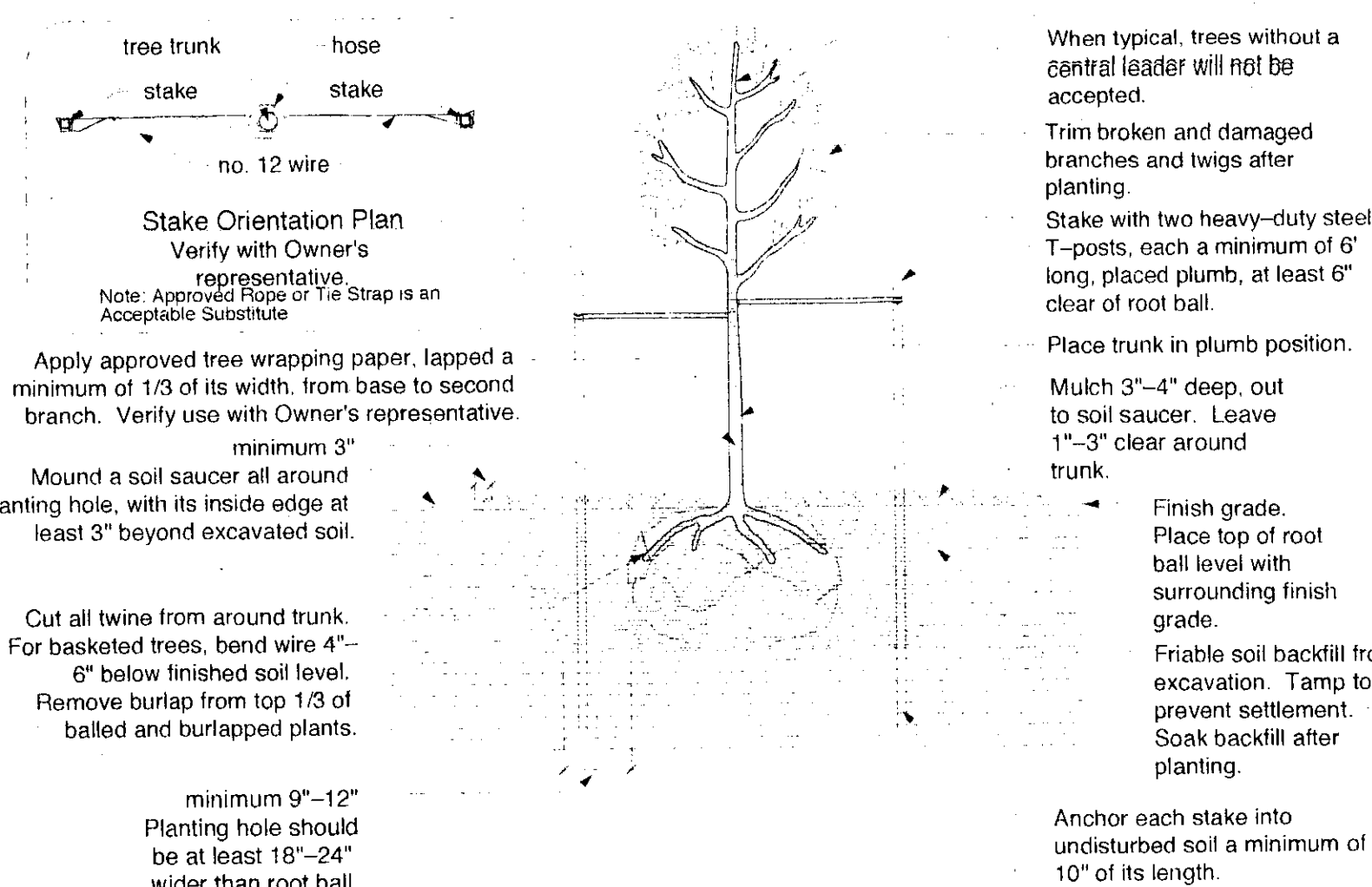

PLANTING SPECIFICATIONS

General

- The landscape contractor shall provide all plants, materials, labor and equipment to complete the installation of trees, planting beds and installation of fescue lawn areas according to these specifications, the planting plans and City of Wichita Planning Department requirements. Do not estimate native grass installation.
- Prior to landscape work, flag all underground utilities by calling Kansas One-Call.
- Notify the Owner's Representative of variances between the plan and site conditions which affect planting operations.
- Prior to the start of work, the Landscape Contractor shall spray to kill weeds and grass in planting bed and lawn areas as directed. Use Round-up or similar chemical in as many applications required for complete kill.
- Water for installation purposes is provided by hose bibs at the building.
- All landscape areas to be watered by an underground irrigation system except buffalograss and native grass areas noted on plan. Verify water source tap with contractor. Note that a test of the well water source showed high salt content. Irrigation system shall be planned with low angle trajectory heads or drip irrigation near plantings to avoid water spray on plants.

Materials and Installation Requirements

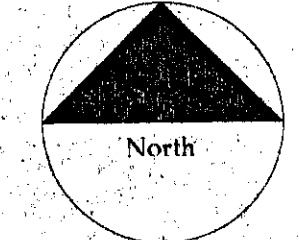
Materials shall be approved by the Owner's Representative before start of work. Materials and grass may be rejected at any time during the installation.

Topsoil shall be provided by the landscape contractor as required for finished grading. This is intended only for low areas in planting beds and not the entire site.
Plant Materials shall meet current American National Standards Institute standards and exhibit a vigorous and healthy condition. Mulch to be recycled hardwood mulch.

Maintenance, Acceptance and Guarantee

- Prior to acceptance, the planting and grass areas shall be maintained, watered and kept clean and weed free by the Landscape Contractor.
- When landscape work is completed, the Landscape Contractor and Owner's Representative shall meet to review the installation. If the installation is in accordance with the plans and specifications, the Owner's Representative shall accept the work. If not, the Owner's Representative may require additional work before acceptance. The Landscape Contractor shall provide maintenance recommendations to the Owner.
- Landscape Contractor shall direct the Irrigation Contractor and Owner in setting the watering schedule.
- Guarantee for spring planted plants shall be through August 31. Guarantee for fall planted plants shall be through May 31.
- At the end of the guarantee period the Owner's Representative and Landscape Contractor shall meet to review for replacements. Dead plants and those not in a vigorous, thriving condition shall be replaced as originally specified in the following planting season. There shall be no additional cost to the Owner for replacements except due to vandalism. Grass areas not acceptable shall be reseeded immediately in the same planting season or if weather conditions require, the following season.

PLANTS SHALL COMPLY IN ALL APPLICABLE RESPECTS WITH ACCEPTABLE STANDARDS AS SET FORTH IN THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF NURSERYMANS' "AMERICAN STANDARD OF NURSERY STOCK". OWNER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT AT ANY TIME OR PLACE PRIOR TO FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF WORK, ANY AND ALL PLANTS WHICH IN THEIR OPINION FAIL TO MEET THESE SPECIFICATION REQUIREMENTS.
5. PLANTS DESIGNATED CONTAINER GROWN SHALL HAVE BEEN GROWN IN POTS, CANS OR BOXES FOR A MINIMUM OF SIX MONTHS AND A MAXIMUM OF TWO YEARS. THESE PLANTS SHALL BE REMOVED FROM CONTAINERS BEFORE PLANTING. PLANTS THAT APPEAR ROOT-BOUND SHALL BE ROOT-PRUNED THROUGH THE USE OF A VERTICAL SLICING METHOD PRIOR TO PLANTING.
6. WRAP ALL TREE TRUNKS SPIRALLY WITH APPROVED WRAPPING MATERIAL FROM GROUND TO THE FIRST BRANCH. SECURELY TIE WRAPPING AT THE TOP AND BOTTOM WITH MASKING TAPE. TREES SHALL BE SUPPORTED IMMEDIATELY AFTER PLANTING IN THE MANNER SHOWN ON TREE PLANTING DETAIL.
7. AFTER PLANTING IS COMPLETED, REPAIR INJURIES TO ALL PLANTS AS REQUIRED. LIMIT AMOUNT OF PRUNING TO A MINIMUM NECESSARY TO REMOVE DEAD OR INJURED TWIGS AND BRANCHES. PRUNE IN SUCH A MANNER AS NOT TO CHANGE NATURAL HABIT OR SHAPE OF PLANT. MAKE CUTS FLUSH, LEAVING NO STUBS.
8. PLANTING BEDS RECEIVING MULCH ARE TO BE FREE OF WEEDS AND GRASS. TREAT BEDS WITH A PRE-EMERGENT HERBICIDE PRIOR TO PLANTING AND MULCH PLACEMENT. APPLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD TRADE PRACTICE.
9. GUARANTEE ALL SEED AREAS FOR 90 DAYS AFTER SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION.
10. GUARANTEE TREES AND SHRUBS FOR ONE CALENDAR YEAR FOLLOWING PROVISIONAL ACCEPTANCE OF THE OVERALL PROJECT. DURING THE GUARANTEE PERIOD, PLANTS THAT DIE DUE TO NATURAL CAUSES OR THAT ARE UNHEALTHY OR UNSIGHTLY IN CONDITION, SHALL BE REPLACED BY THE CONTRACTOR. PLANTS USED FOR THE REPLACEMENT SHALL BE OF THE SAME VARIETY AND SIZE AS ORIGINALLY SPECIFIED IN THE PLANT SCHEDULE. REPLACEMENTS SHALL BE MADE WITHIN TWO DAYS OF REQUEST PENDING FAVORABLE SEASONAL PLANTING TIMES.
11. GUARANTEE WILL NOT BE ENFORCED SHOULD THE PLANT MATERIAL DIE DUE TO VANDALISM OVER OR UNDER WATERING BY THE OWNER, IMPROPER MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES CARRIED OUT BY THE OWNER INVOLVING LAWN MOWER DAMAGE, OVER FERTILIZATION, ACTS NOT RELATED TO CONTRACTUAL RESPONSIBILITIES OF CONTRACTOR OF SIMILAR CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CONTRACTOR.
12. REMOVE ALL RUBBISH, EQUIPMENT AND MATERIAL AND LEAVE THE AREA IN A NEAT, CLEAN CONDITION EACH DAY. MAINTAIN PAVED AREAS UTILIZED FOR HAULING EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS BY OTHER TRADES IN A CLEAN AND UNOBSTRUCTED CONDITION AT ALL TIMES. REMOVE SOIL OR DIRT THAT ACCUMULATED DURING OR AS A RESULT OF PLANTING OPERATIONS EACH DAY.
13. AT THE COMPLETION OF PLANTING OPERATIONS, ALL PLANTS SHALL BE INSPECTED BY THE OWNER. CONTRACTOR SHALL REPLACE IMMEDIATELY ANY PLANTS NOT IN HEALTHY AND VIGOROUS CONDITION AT THAT TIME AT NO EXPENSE TO THE OWNER. ANY PLANT NOT IN HEALTHY CONDITION AFTER ONE FULL YEAR FROM THE DATE OF FINAL ACCEPTANCE SHALL BE REPLACED AS PER THE ORIGINAL SPECIFICATIONS, FREE OF CHARGE TO THE OWNER.
14. LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR TO REMOVE TREE STAKES, TREE WRAP, AND REMOVE ALL DEAD WOOD ON TREES AND SHRUBS ONE YEAR AFTER FINAL ACCEPTANCE.
15. NO SUBSTITUTIONS SHALL BE ALLOWED WITHOUT APPROVAL.
16. ANY PLANTING BED ADJACENT TO WALKS OR CURBING SHALL HAVE THE GRADE TO A SUFFICIENT DEPTH TO ALLOW TOP OF THE MULCH TO MATCH THE TOP OF WALK OR CURBING.
17. FERTILIZER WITH MILORGANITE, DISTRIBUTED UNIFORMLY AT THE RATE OF 1000 POUNDS PER ACRE.
18. PRIOR TO SEEDING, MOW, GRUB RAKE ALL VEGETATION WHICH MIGHT INTERFERE AND REMOVE ALL DEBRIS FROM THE SITE. THOROUGHLY TILL AREA AFTER PREPARATION, TO A DEPTH OF AT LEAST 6 INCHES.
19. SUBMIT TYPEWRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS RECOMMENDING PROCEDURES TO BE ESTABLISHED BY OWNER FOR MAINTENANCE OF LANDSCAPE WORK.
20. LABEL AT LEAST 1 TREE, 1 SHRUB, AND 1 GROUND COVER OF EACH VARIETY WITH A SECURELY ATTACHED WATERPROOF TAG BEARING LEGIBLE DESIGNATION OF BOTANICAL AND COMMON NAMES.
21. PLANT TREES, SHRUBS AND GROUND COVERS DURING NORMAL SEASON FOR SUCH WORK. DO NOT PLANT IN FROZEN GROUND.
22. MAINTAIN PLANT MATERIAL UNTIL FINAL ACCEPTANCE BY OWNER. MAINTENANCE CONSISTS OF SPRAYING PRUNING, WATERING AND WEEDING AS REQUIRED FOR HEALTHY GROWTH. REMOVE AND REPLACE PLANT MATERIAL FOUND TO BE DEAD OR IN AN UNHEALTHY CONDITION.

5. COORDINATE IRRIGATION SYSTEM INSTALLATION WITH LANDSCAPE WORK.
6. THE IRRIGATION SYSTEM IS TO BE DESIGNED WITH RAIN BIRD SPRINKLER MANUFACTURING CO. OR EQUAL PRODUCTS AND MATERIALS. OTHER MANUFACTURERS AS APPROVED BY ARCHITECT
7. COORDINATE LOCATION OF THE CONTROLLER WITH THE OWNER.
8. INSTALL BACKFLOW PREVENTER, SHUT OFF VALVE AND MANUAL DRAIN VALVE PER LOCAL PLUMBING CODES. PROVIDE PLASTIC TRUNCATED ENCLOSURE FOR THE BACKFLOW PREVENTER AS PROVIDED BY THE MANUFACTURER.
9. PROVISIONS SHALL BE MADE TO WINTERIZE THE PIPING SYSTEM.

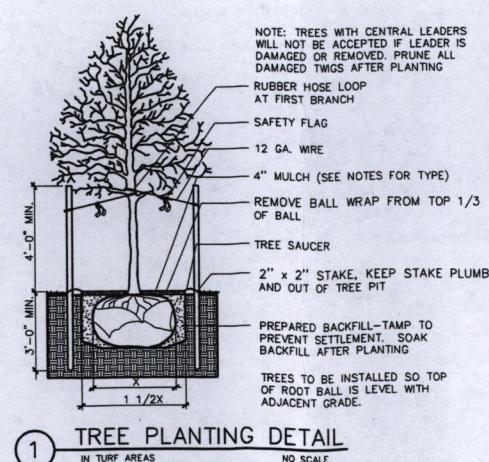

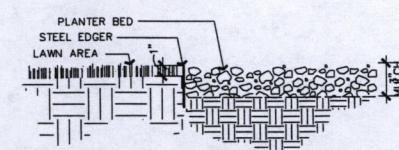
