

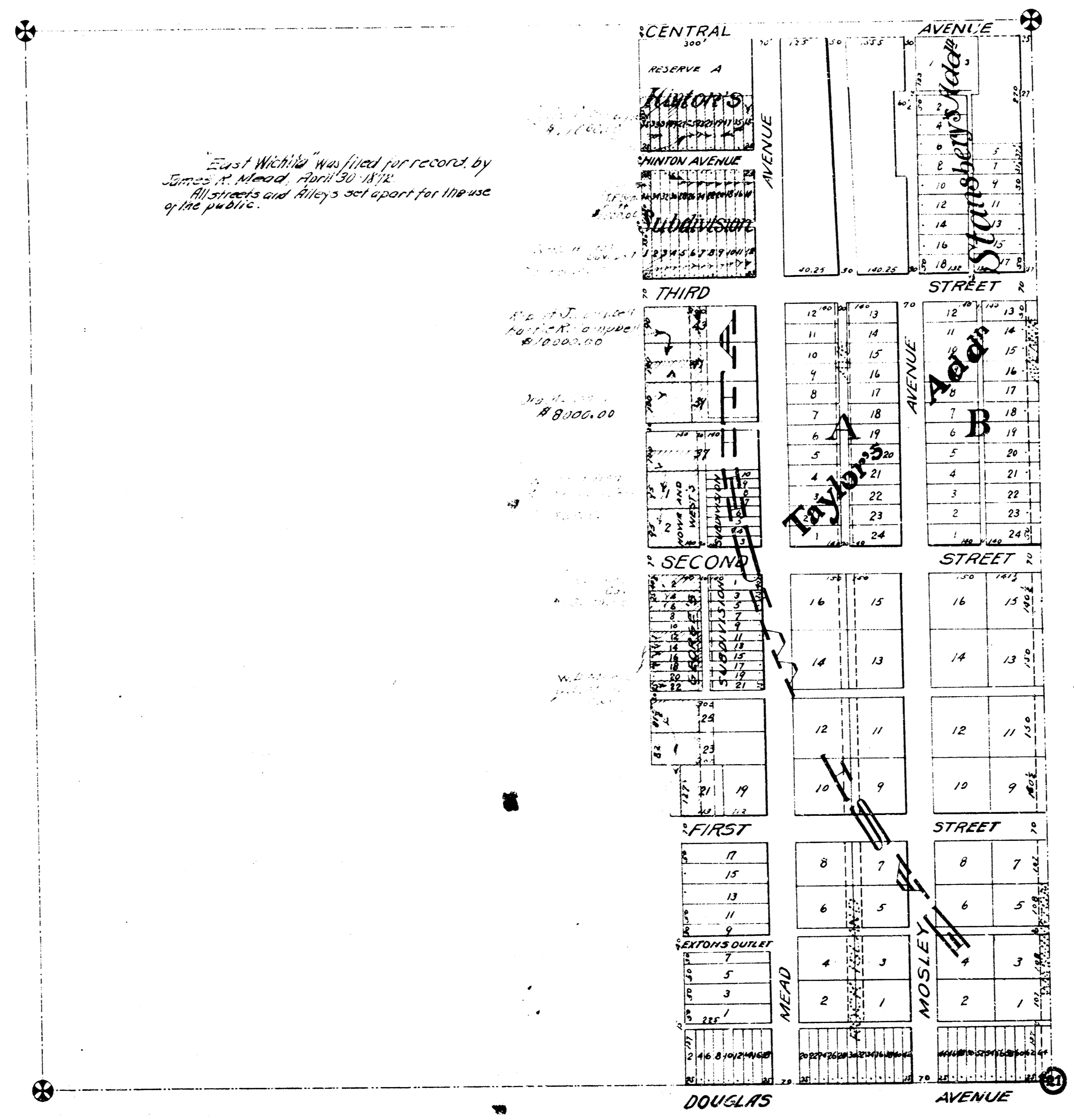

 corner of 30th and Central Avenue in J. R. Mead's Addition to the
 City of Wichita thence South to the east side of 30th Ave. 248 feet
 thence east 300 feet thence north 200 feet thence west 300 feet
 to point of beginning.
