Burr's Addition to the City of Wichita Kansas
consists of the following described property, in
Sedgwick County, Kas. Bounded as follows: Commencing
at the south east corner of of Section Twenty one (21)
Town Twenty Seven (27) Range one (1) East; thence
west Seven hundred & fifty (750) feet. Thence North
Seven hundred & twenty six (726) feet. Thence East
Two hundred & sixty one (261) feet. Thence north One
hundred & sixty five (165) feet. Thence East Four hundred
& eighty eight (488) feet to section line. Thence
South eight hundred & ninety one (891) feet to place of
beginning. The Streets in this Addition are the
following: Hunter Avenue Sixty (60) feet.
Ellis Avenue Sixty feet (60) Kellogg Street & Hydraulic
Avenue Thirty (30) feet each to section line. The alleys
are twenty (20) feet wide. All lots north of Hunter
Avenue are 25 feet front by 165 feet deep, except lot
No. 1 which is 33 1/2 feet front by 165 feet deep. All lots
south of Hunter Avenue are 40 feet deep by 25 feet front
except the four south lots siding on Kellogg Street which
are 38 feet front each.

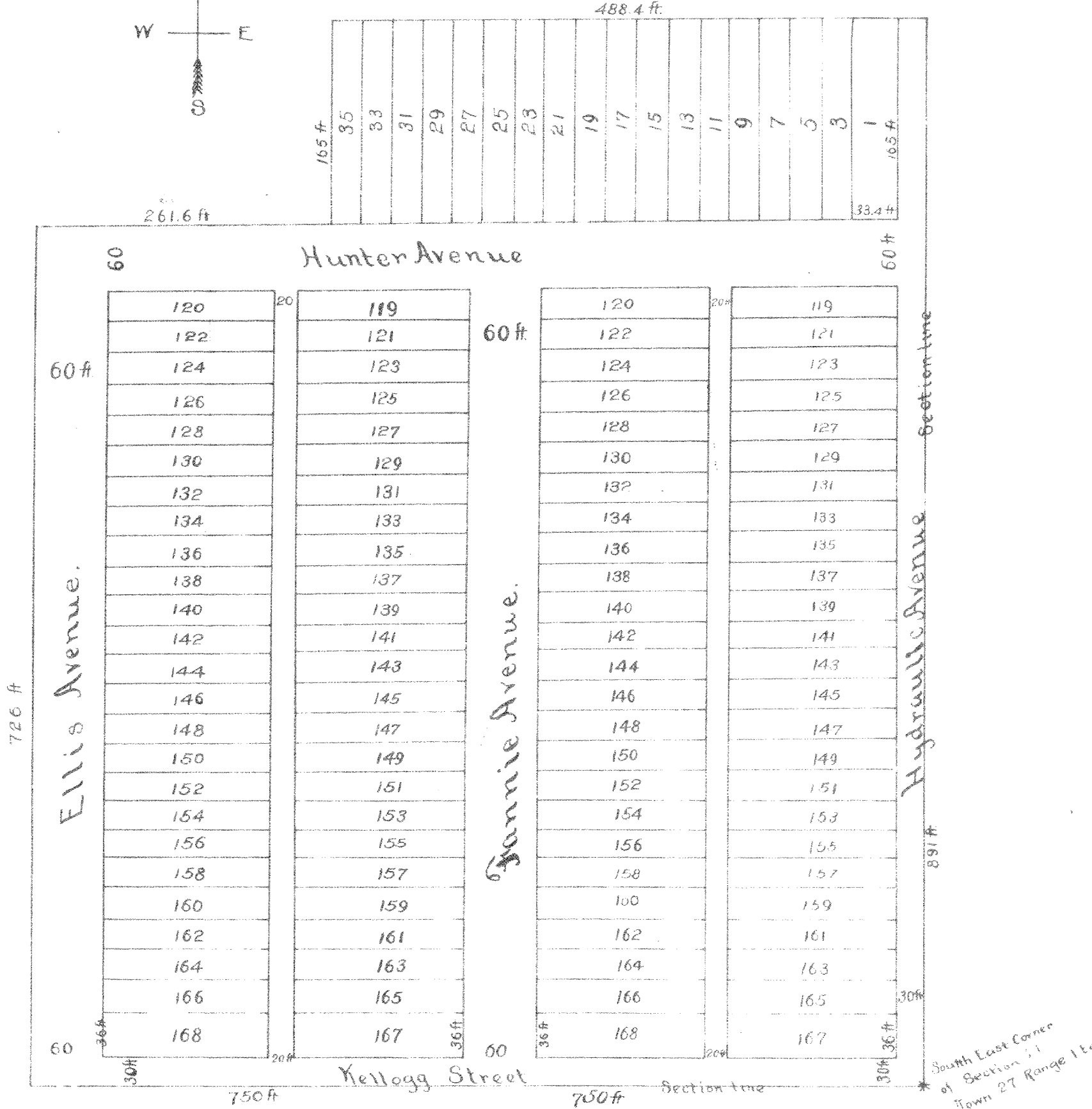
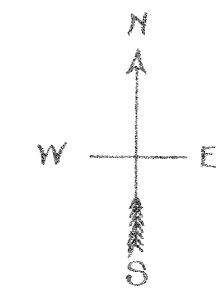
