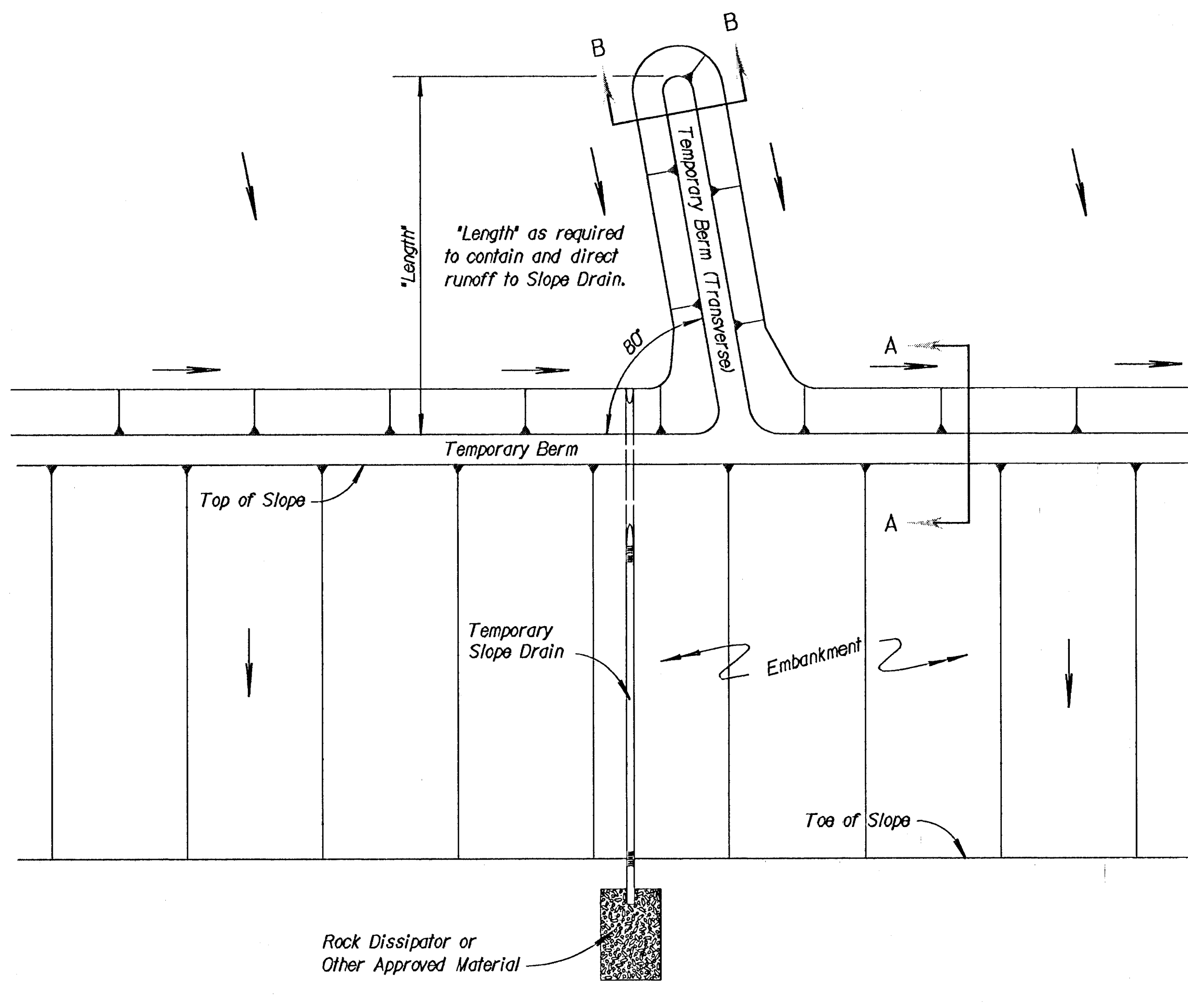
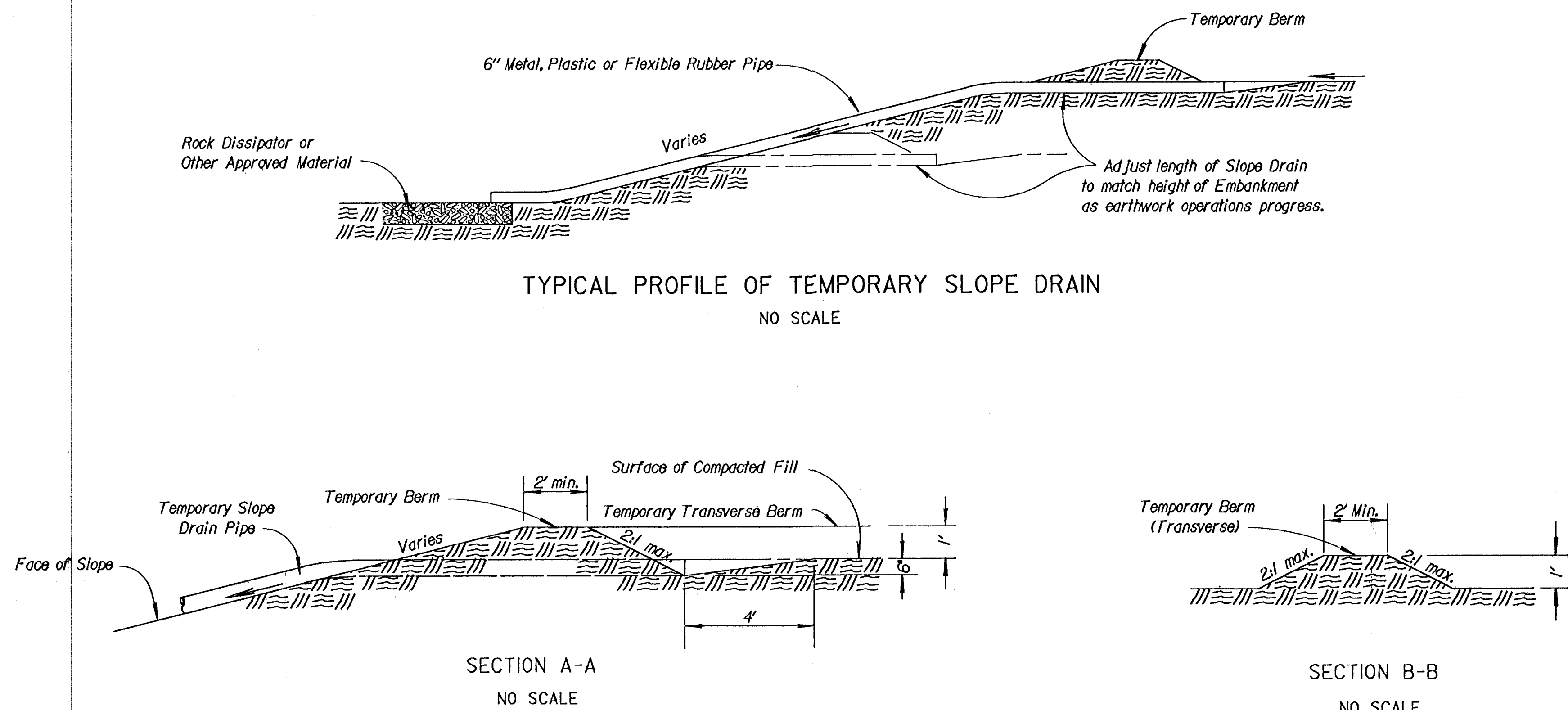

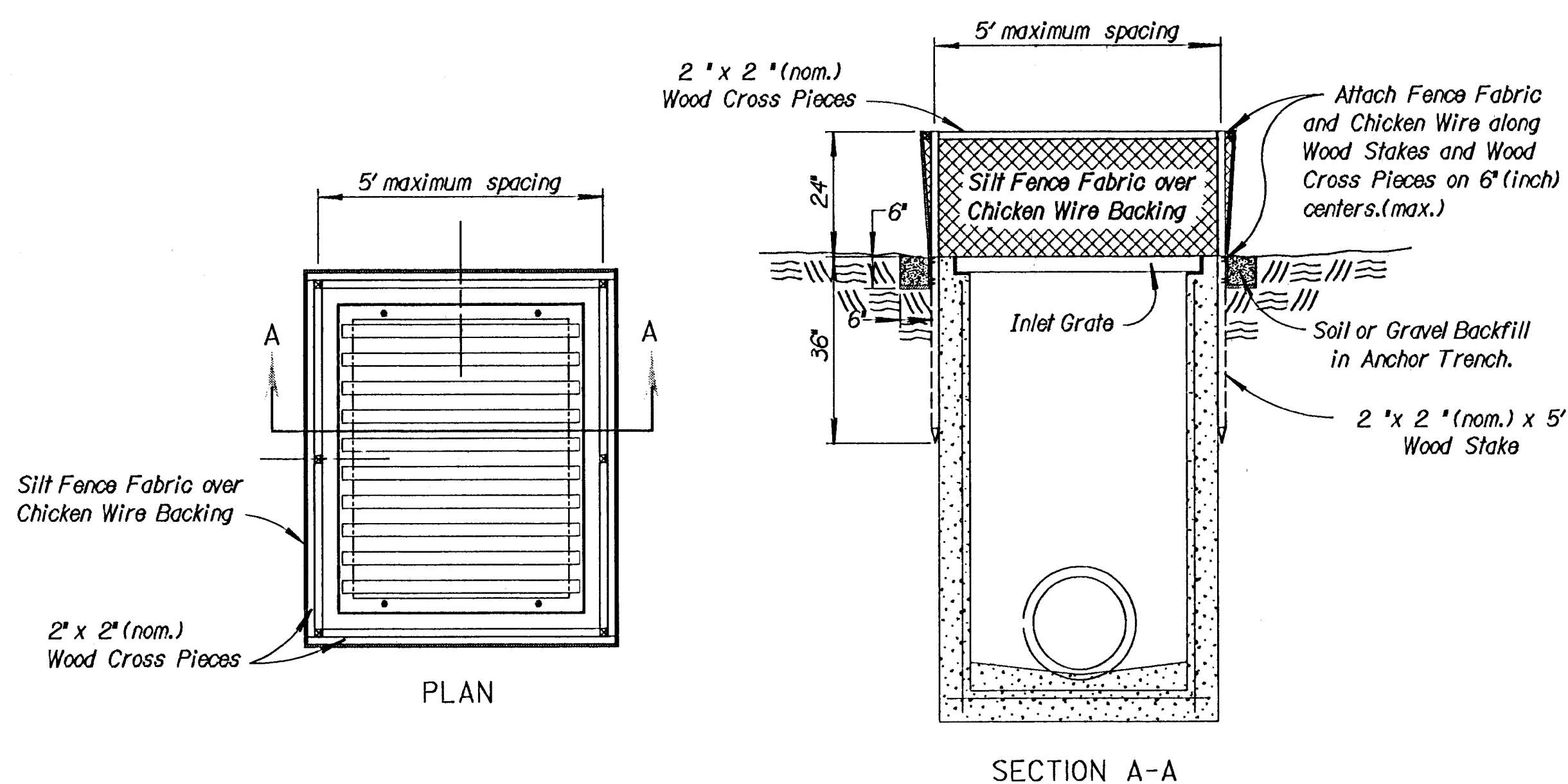


TYPICAL PROFILE OF TEMPORARY SLOPE DRAIN

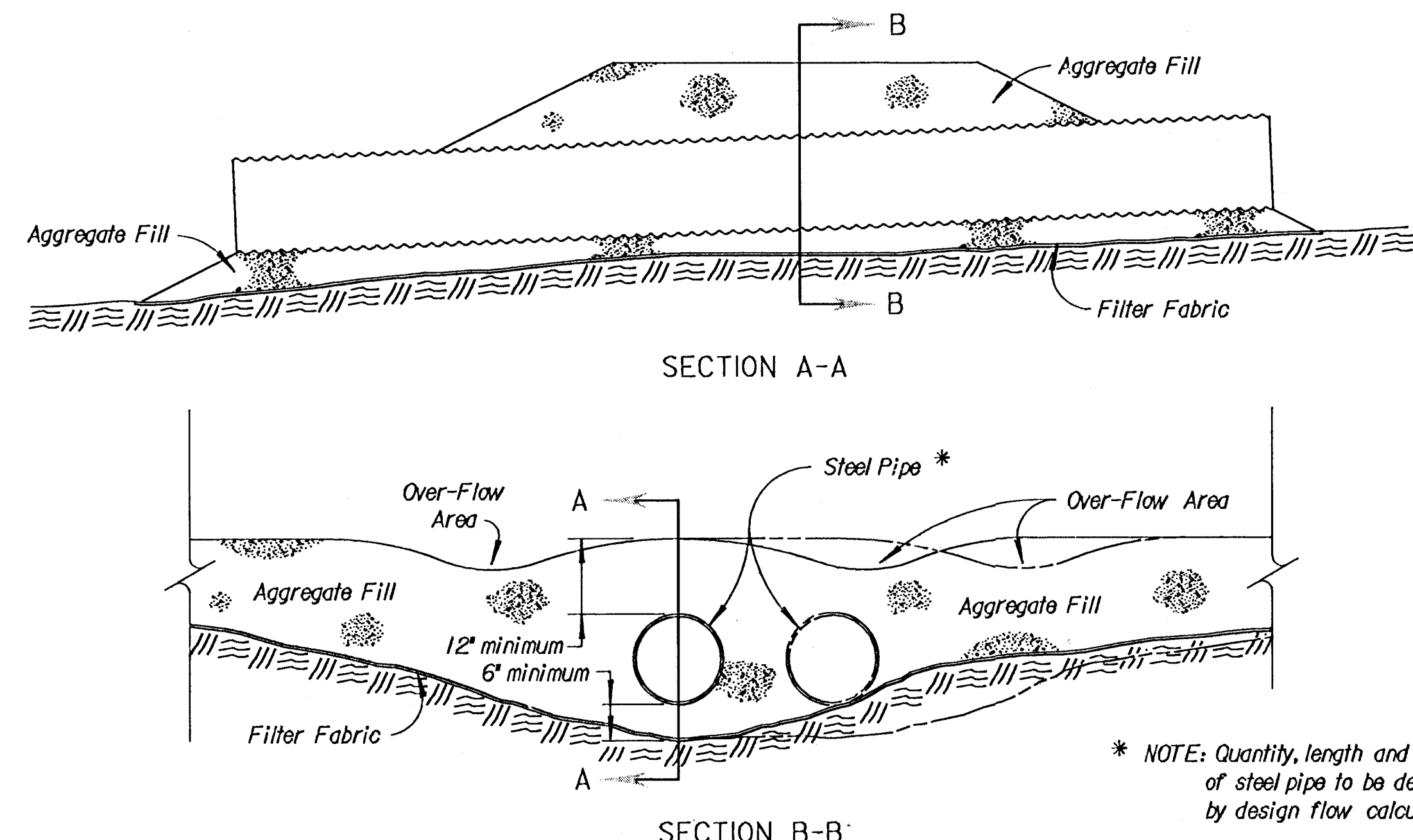
