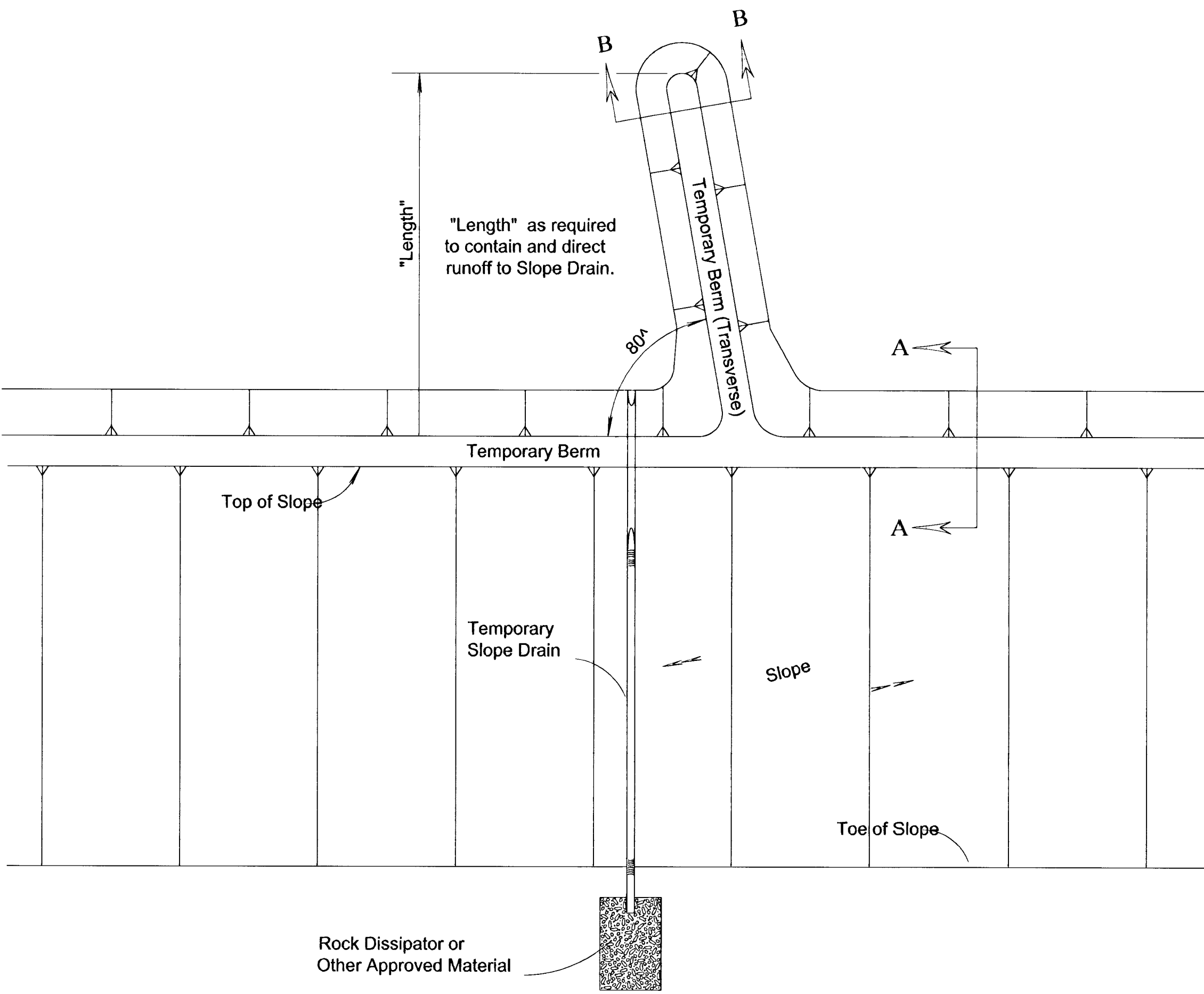
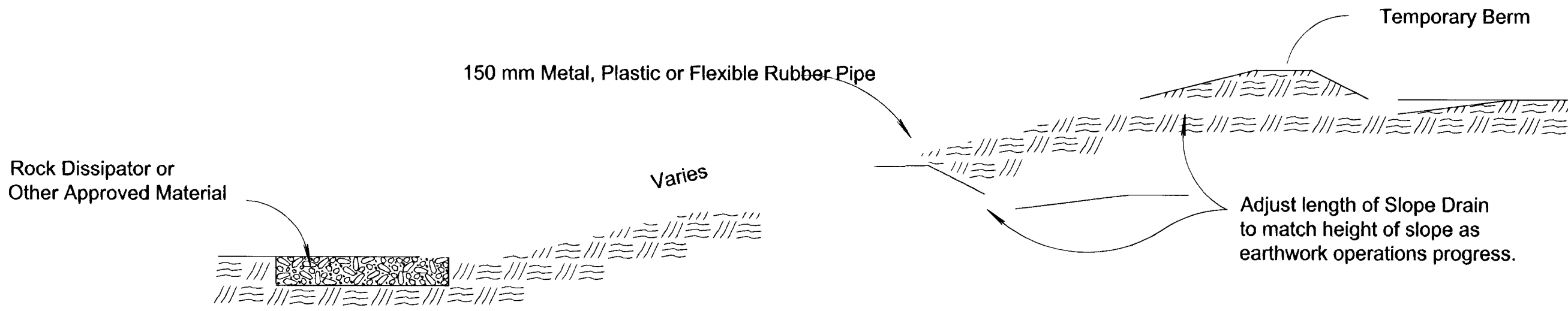


- NOTES:

 - 3) Pipe shall be secured in place as approved by Engineer.

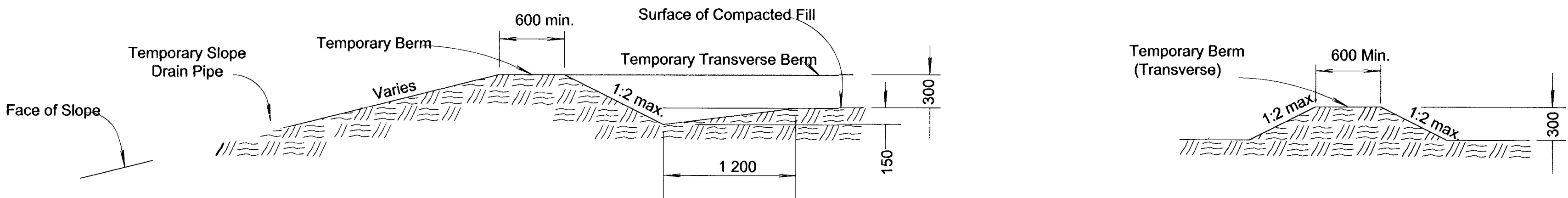

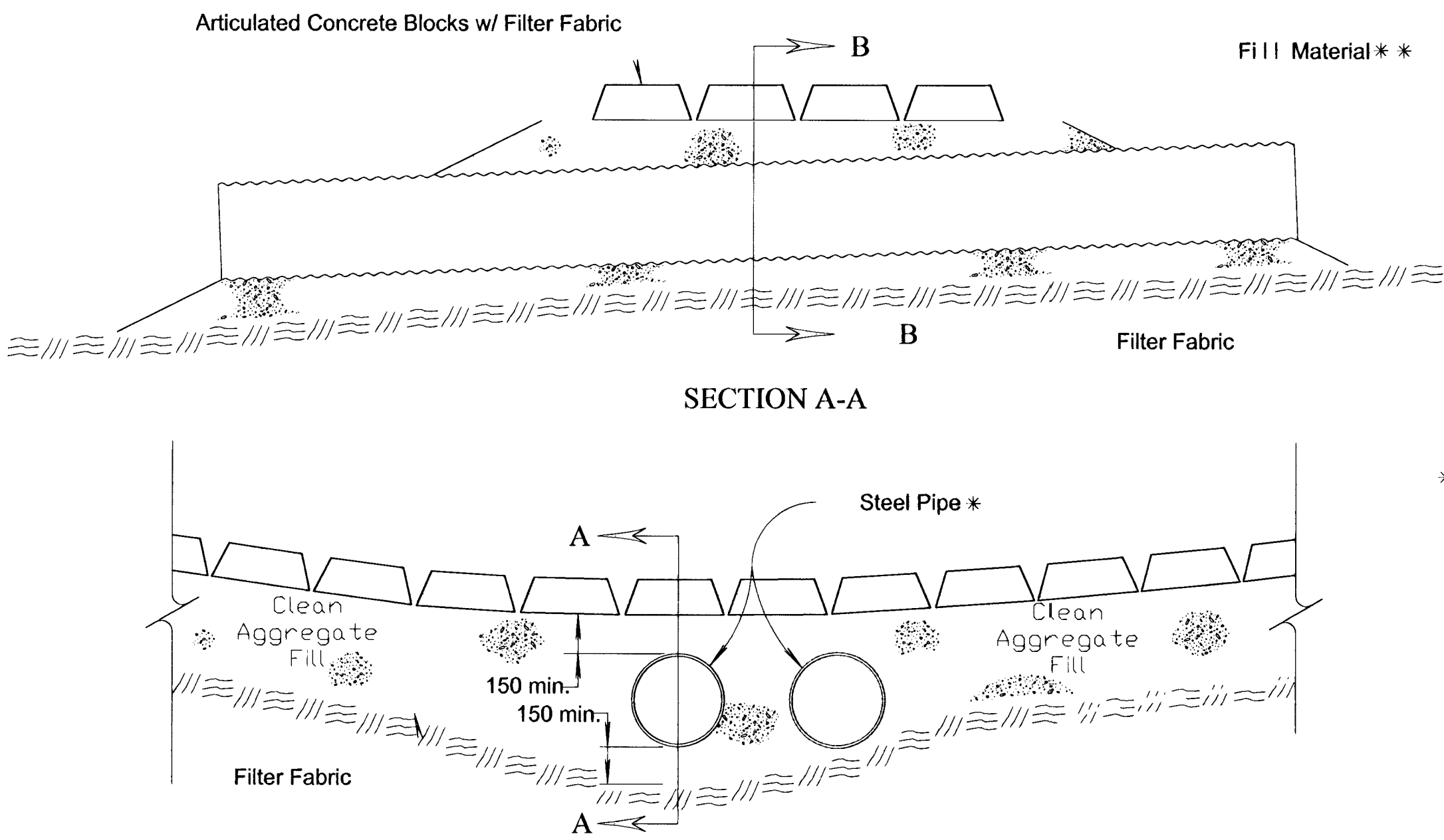
TYPICAL PROFILE OF TEMPORARY SLOPE DRAIN

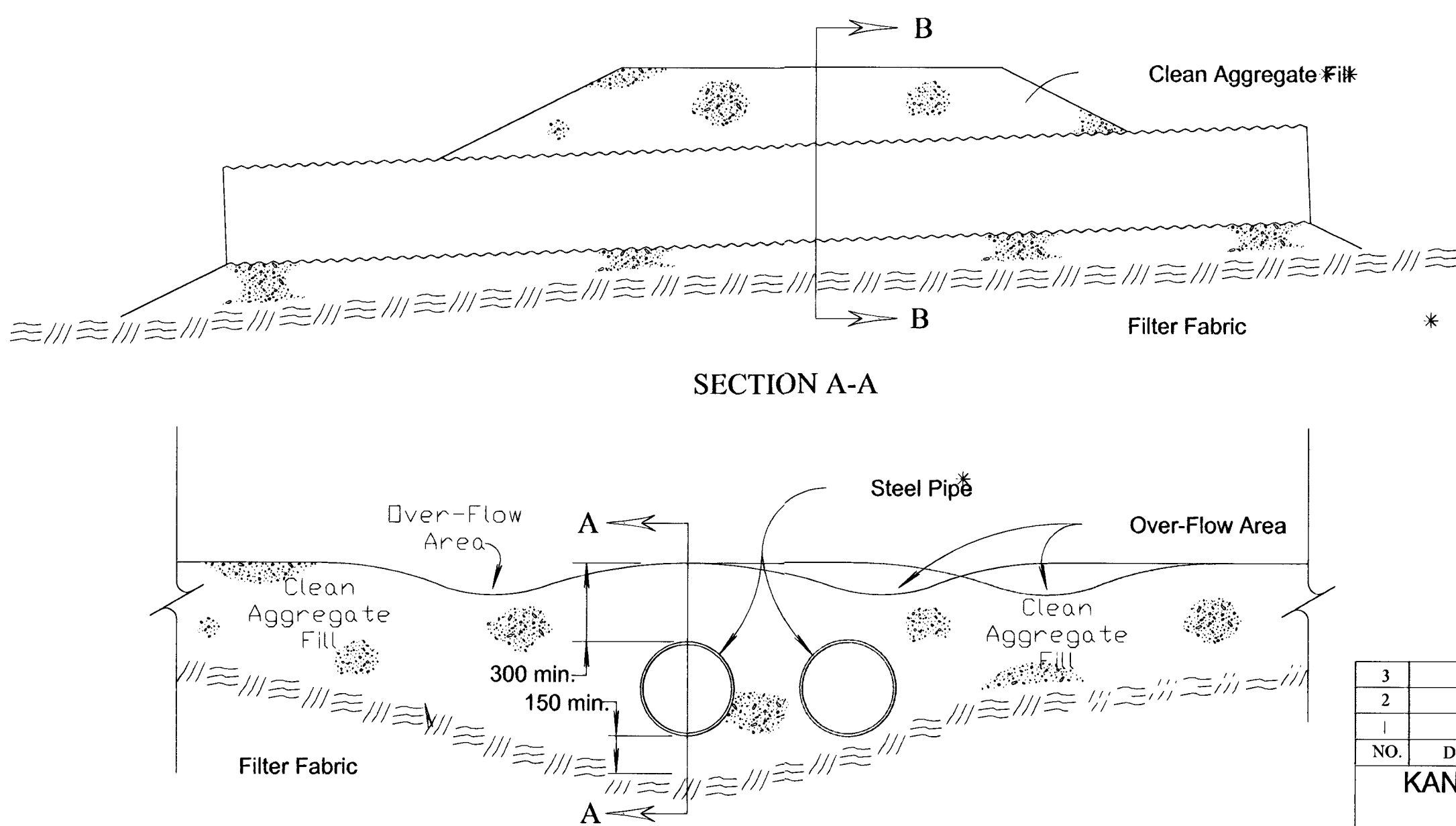
