
Re: Farmington Square

Discussion centered around final plat of Farmington Square.

1. Mr. Linn stated he did not have any objection to spreading cost of storm drainage ditch by special assessments. The cost of the entire ditch can be charged to our property without any problems. Mr. Linn stated that the LHA would have to be contacted to approve their sharing the cost of ditch. Mr. Higgins will contact LHA in regard to their participation in cost of project.
2. Mr. Linn stated he would confirm hydrology study in area to west of our site to confirm design of ditch. Problem here is his staff is extremely busy and could cause time delay in project.
3. It was generally agreed with Mr. Mitchell and Mr. Linn that a pipe system was the best solution for storm drainage at southeast corner of property.
