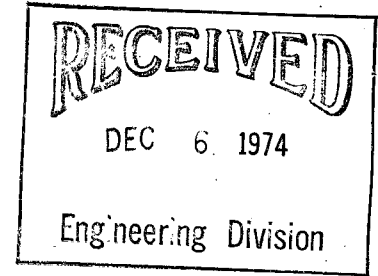

Dear Mr. Higgins:

Your letter of October 25, 1974 was presented to the Board of Housing Commissioners at their Regular Meeting on November 25, 1974.

The Board instructed me to inform you that although they were confident that any development of the surrounding landsite could possibly enhance the Country Acres Housing Project development; however, they were not sure that a drainage ditch, as proposed, would benefit and/or improve the LHA project. Therefore, they did not feel that they would have sound justification to recommend to the City Commission expenditure of City funds to defray any of the development cost for a drainage ditch.

The lateness in my response to your request is due to the effect that I must receive Board review and action on all policy matters.
