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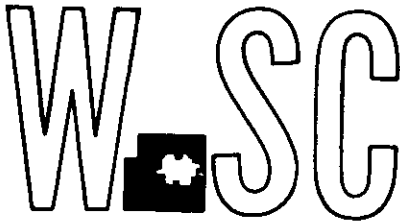

Dear Mr. Diebold:

Since the subject property has not been redeveloped and is being used
in a manner identical to the way it was being used prior to replat-
ting, we can authorize a one-year extension of time to complete the
above-referenced work. This extension of time can be granted subject
to an amendment to your letter of credit being submitted which refer-
ences the following:

1. A new dollar amount of \$2,400.00;
2. A new expiration date for negotiation of January 19, 1984;

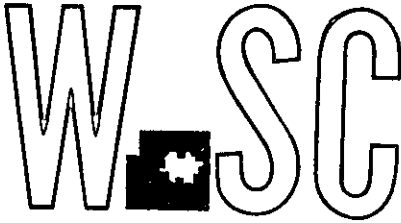

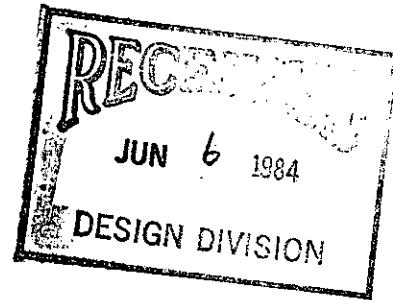


Thank you for your letter of May 16, in which you notified us that TOTAL Petroleum has sold the property at 8000 East Douglas to R & H Properties. I have checked with Central Inspection and verified that a building permit has been issued for redevelopment of the property. This permit does provide for the closure of the two driveway approaches located immediately east and north of the Rock Road and Douglas intersection. As you are aware, those are the two drive approaches in violation of the platted access control existing on this property.

I field-checked the property earlier this week and noted that the site has been cleared but that no new construction is occurring. I also noted that the two drive approaches are still unclosed. I assume closure of the driveways will occur during construction of the new building on this property.



Since the driveways are still open, I cannot release the letter of credit. Please have R & H Properties notify me when the work has actually been completed. At that time, I will promptly release the letter of credit and return the original document to the Commercial Operations Officer of Fourth National Bank.

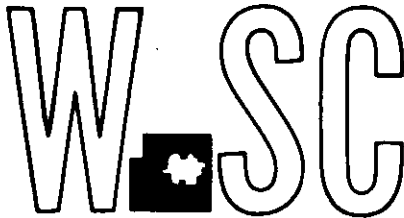

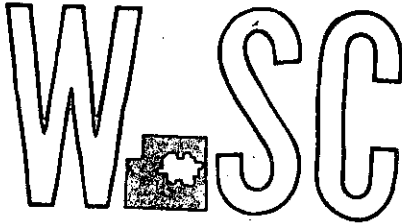

required by the platting of Vickers Rock Road Addition
(S/D 80-35).

Dear Mr. Tyson:

As was agreed at the above-referenced meeting, we are willing to grant a series of two-year time extensions for completion of two curb cut closures on Vickers Rock Road Addition provided that the existing station is not remodeled and the City continues to have no immediate plans for construction of a major street intersection at Rock Road and Douglas. The intent of this agreement is to allow Total Petroleum to complete the required curb cut closures in conjunction with the eventual remodeling of the service station. We understand that closure of the driveways prior to station remodeling would interrupt the circulation system for the existing gasoline pumps.

As you are aware, your existing letter of credit from Fourth National Bank and Trust Company guaranteeing the above-referenced improvements matures on November 19, 1983. Prior to this date, it is necessary for you to contact the bank relative to providing an amendment which extends the life of the letter of credit (Credit Number 745). The requirement amendment needs to reference the following:


- A. A new default or project completion date of November 19, 1985;
- B. A new negotiation or expiration date of January 19, 1986.
