To the Board of Commissioners,

Dear Commissioners:

1. We, the undersigned owners of record as below designated, of lots, parcels, and tracts of real property described as follows:

Lots 76 through 83 inclusive, Washington Square Addition; also Lot 2, Daniels Addition; and also the East three hundred thirty-eight and five tenths (338.5) feet of the South one hundred forty-eight and three tenths (148.3) feet and the West two hundred eight (208) feet of the South one hundred forty-eight and three tenths (148.3) feet of Lot 8, Riverside Gardens

do hereby petition, pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 1974 Supp. 12-6a01 et seq, as follows:

- (a) That there be constructed pavement on 43rd Street South from the East line of Alfalfa Street to the East line of Washington Avenue; that said pavement between aforesaid limits be constructed for a width of 26 feet from gutter line to gutter line, cement combined curb and gutter to be 2 feet and 6 inches in width, making a total roadway of 30 feet; that said pavement shall consist of an asphaltic concrete base 6 inches in thickness, and an asphaltic concrete wearing surface 2 inches in thickness, composed of stone, sand, mineral filler, and asphalt according to specifications to be furnished by the City Engineer.
- (b) That the estimated and probable cost of the foregoing improvement being \$31,000.00 payable by the improvement district and \$5,000.00 payable by the City of Wichita at large for Intersection. Said estimated cost as above setforth is hereby increased at the pro-rata rate of 1% per month from and after the date of approval of this petition.
- (c) That the land or area above described be constituted as an improvement district against which shall be assessed 100% of the total cost of the improvements for which the improvement district is liable.
- (d) That the method of assessment of all costs for the improvements for which the improvement district shall be liable shall be on a fractional basis, Lots 76 through 83 inclusive, Washington Square Addition shall each pay 10/165 of the total cost payable by the improvement district; Lot 2, Daniels Addition shall pay 12/165 of the total cost payable by the improvement district; the East three hundred thirty-eight and five tenths (338.5) feet of the South one hundred forty-eight and three tenths (148.3) feet and the West two hundred eight (208) feet of the South one hundred forty-eight and three tenths (148.3) feet of Lot 8, Riverside Gardens shall pay 73/165 of the total cost payable by the improvement district; except when driveways are requested to serve a particular tract, lot, or parcel, the cost of said driveway shall be a direct assessment to said tract, lot, or parcel and shall be in addition to the assessment for other improvements.

2. It is requested that the improvements hereby petitioned be made without notice and hearing, which, but for this request, would be required by K.S.A. 12-6a04.

3. That names may not be withdrawn from this petition by the signers thereof after the Governing Body commences consideration of the petition or later than seven (7) days after filing, which ever occurs first.

4. That when this petition has been filed with the City Clerk and it has been certified that the signatures thereon are according to the records of the Register of Deeds of Sedgwick County, Kansas, the petition may be found sufficient if signed by either (1) a majority of the resident owners of record of property liable for assessment under the proposal, or (2) the resident owners of record of more than one-half of the area liable for assessment under the proposal, or (3) the owners of record (whether resident or not) of more than one-half of the area liable for assessment under the proposal. The Governing Body is requested to proceed in the manner provided by statute to the end that the petitioned improvements may be expeditiously completed and placed in use.

Preliminary estimates place the cost of completing the project at \$66,500.00. Based on this estimate, assessments to individual properties in the benefit district are expected to be \$0.07 per square foot.

The Special Assessment Assistance Program approved for CDA funding provides for payment of special assessments for owners who meet the income guidelines of this program. Detailed information regarding this program may be obtained from the City Clerk's Office, phone 268-4526.

If you desire, you may express your opinion on this matter by writing the Board of City Commissioners, c/o the Mayor's Office, 1st Floor, City Hall, 455 North Main Street, Wichita, Kansas 67202.
