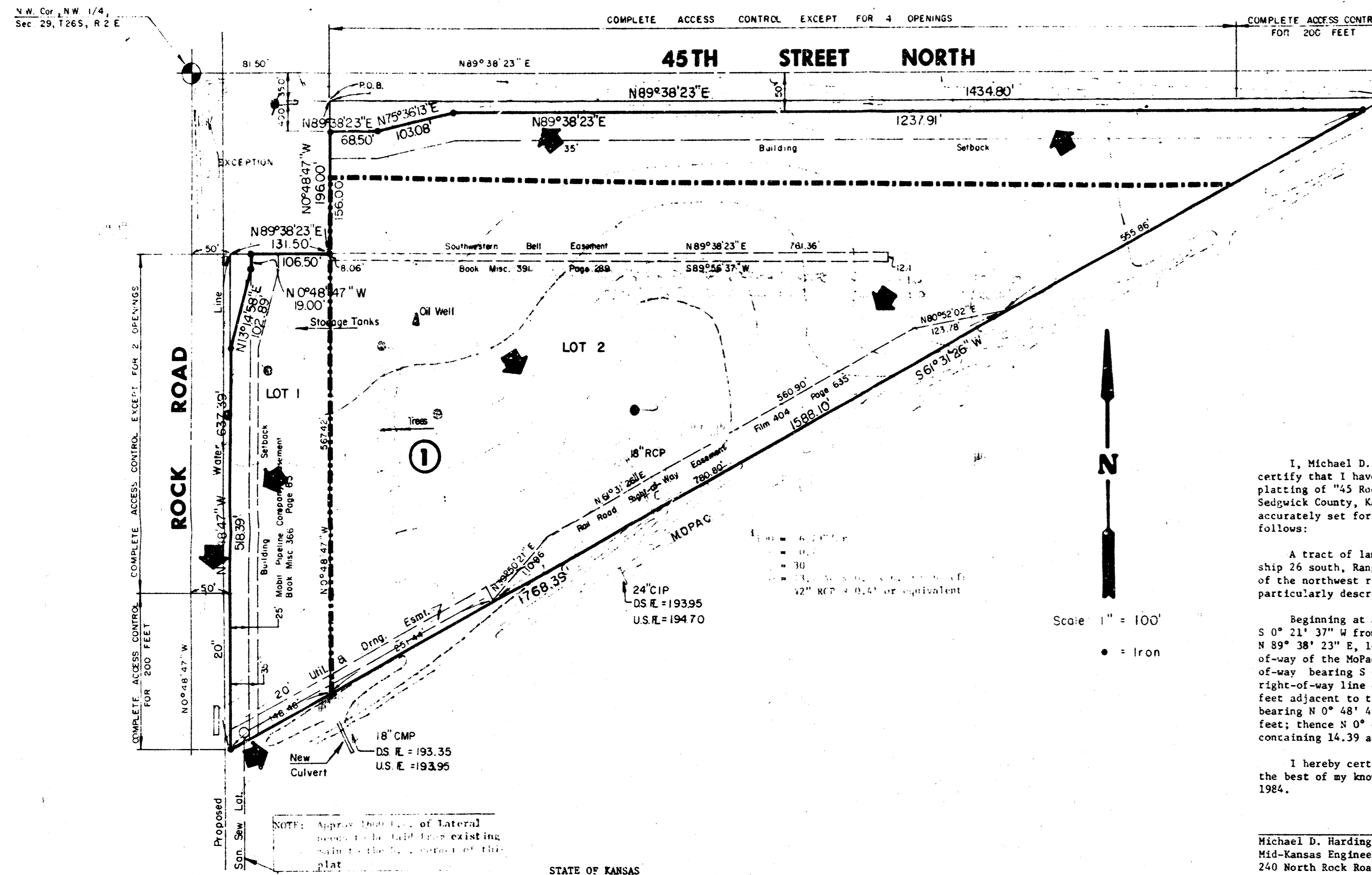


DRAINAGE PLAN FOR 45 ROCK ROAD INDUSTRIAL PARK



I, Michael D. Harding, a Civil Engineer in Kansas, do hereby certify that I have been in responsible charge of surveying and platting of "45 Rock Road Industrial Park", an addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas, into lots and a block, the same being accurately set forth in the accompanying plat and described as follows:

A tract of land in the northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 26 south, Range 2 east of the 6th P.M. lying north and west of the northwest right-of-way line of the MoPAC railroad more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point 181.50 feet N 89° 38' 23" E and 35.00 feet S 0° 21' 37" W from the northwest corner of said Section 29; thence W 89° 38' 23" E, 1534.80 feet to a point on the northwesterly right-of-way of the MoPAC Railroad; thence southwesterly along said right-of-way bearing S 61° 31' 26" W, 1768.39 feet to a point on the east right-of-way line of Rock Road; thence northerly parallel and 50.00 feet adjacent to the west line of said northeast quarter section bearing N 0° 48' 47" W, 637.39 feet; thence N 89° 38' 23" E, 131.50 feet; thence S 0° 48' 47" W, 196.00 feet, to the point of beginning; containing 14.39 acres, more or less.



Dear Mr. Gipson:

In our meeting of November 17, 1986 we discussed the following regarding the drainage structures under the MOPAC railroad right-of-way:

- The spur track is being removed by others at this time.
- The existing ditches and ponding areas along Rock Road and within the site still exist.
- The maintenance building under construction does not substantially alter or increase the drainage directed naturally to MOPAC railroad right-of-way.
- The owner has no immediate plans for the remaining land other than stocking nursery trees.
- Rock Road improvements North of the rail could drain either East or West thereby influencing the size and location of any new culvert under the railroad.
- The owners building is slab on grade and is higher than the existing rail.
