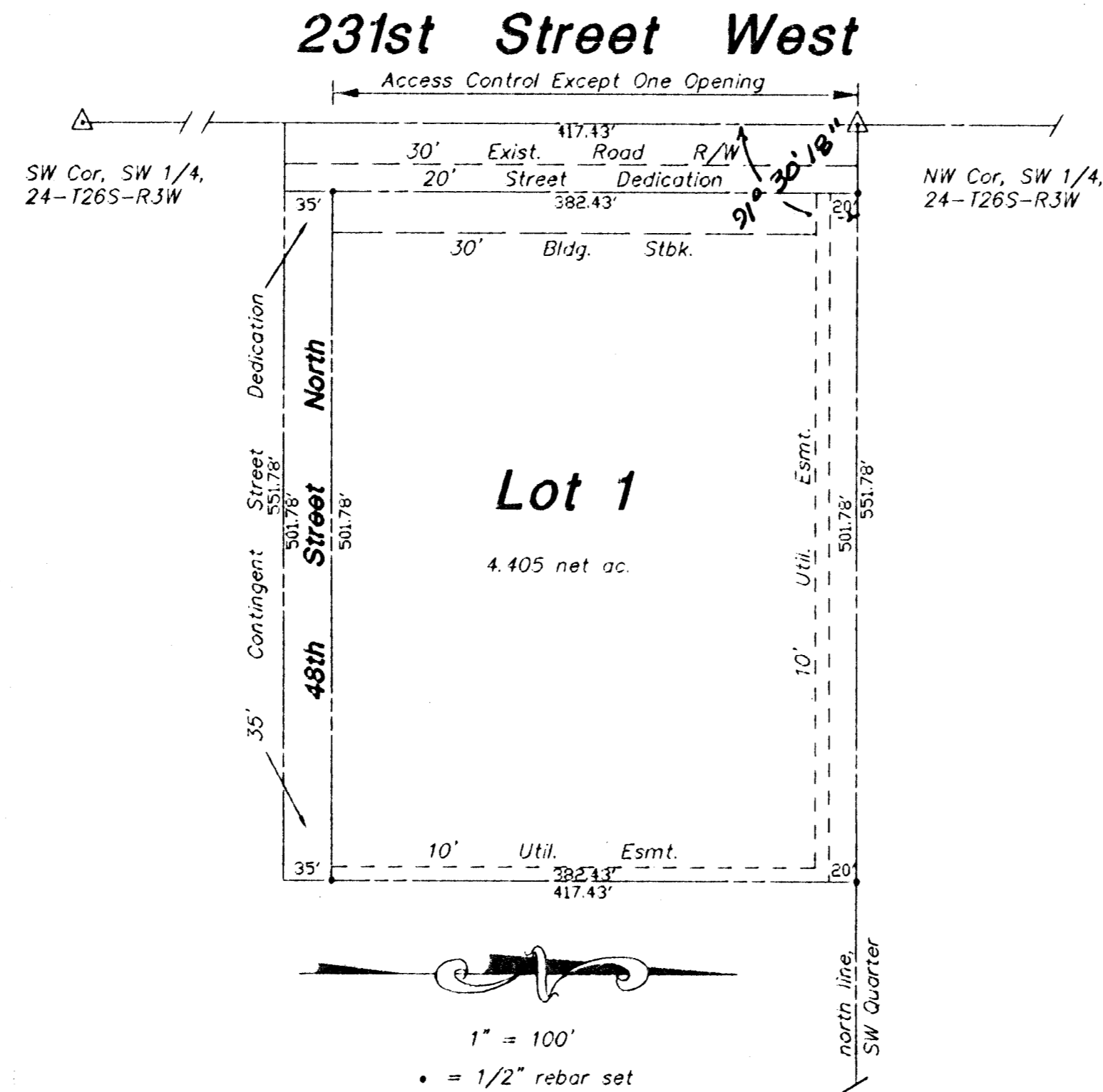

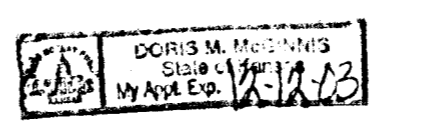

Know all men by these presents that we the undersigned owners of the land described in the Surveyor's Certificate have caused the same to be surveyed and platted into a lot and a street, the same to be known as "Doug Eck First Addition," an addition to Sedgwick County, Kansas. The street is hereby dedicated to and for the use of the public. Utility easements shown on the face of the plat are granted for the construction and maintenance of all public utilities. All abutter's rights of access to or from 231st Street West, over and across the west line of Lot 1, are hereby granted to the appropriate governing body, provided, however that Lot 1 shall have one opening onto 231st Street West at a location approved by the engineer having jurisdiction. The contingent dedication along the south line of the plat shall become effective at such time as a final plat is recorded which covers land south of adjoining this addition and which provides for the dedication of an additional 35 foot street right-of-way.

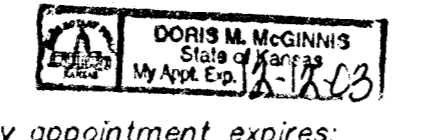
