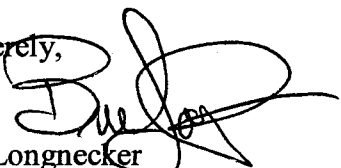

VACATION ORDER

NOW on this 16th day of February, 2016, comes on for hearing the petition for vacation filed by S.J. Ram, LC, c/o Don Walenta (owner), praying for the vacation of the following described platted drainage and utility easement, to-wit:

All of the 20-foot Drainage & Utility Easement located in Block 1, Ann Walenta Commercial Addition, Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

The City Council, after being duly and fully informed as to fully understand the true nature of this petition and the propriety of granting the same, makes the following findings:

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication, as required by law, in The Wichita Eagle on October 29, 2015, which was at least 20 days prior to the public hearing.
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the described platted drainage and utility easement and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. A drainage and utility easement dedicated by separate instrument shall be filed with this Vacation Order at the Sedgwick County Register of Deeds.
4. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
5. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any

owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

6. The vacation of the described platted drainage and utility easement, should be approved.

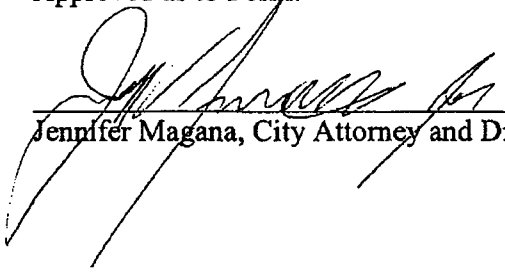
