SUBJECT: Z-2936 - ZONE CHANGE FROM THE "B" MULTIPLE-FAMILY DWELLING DISTRICT TO THE "LC" LIGHT COMMERCIAL DISTRICT, LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF WALNUT BETWEEN BURTON & TEXAS STREETS (District #4).

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

MAPC Recommendation: Approved (7-0).

Staff Recommendation: Approve.

CPO Recommendation: CPO Council 4A recommended approval by a vote of 8-0.

Background: On December 8, 1988, the MAPC held a public hearing to consider a zone change request from the "B" Multiple-Family Dwelling District to the "LC" Light Commercial District for an .8-acre platted site on the east side of Walnut between Burton Street and Texas Street. The site is presently developed with a church structure. The proposed use of a facility for the Arthritis Water Exercise Club is first permitted in the "LC" district.

Recommendations/Actions:

1. Concur with the findings of the MAPC and approve the zone change; place the ordinance establishing the zone change on first reading; or
2. Return the application to the MAPC for reconsideration, stating reasons.

ORDINANCE NO. 40-547

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS OR DISTRICTS OF CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY SECTION 28.04.210, THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That having received a recommendation from the Planning Commission, and proper notice having been given and hearing held as provided by law and under authority and subject to the provisions of Section 28.04.210, The Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas, the zoning classification or districts of the lands legally described hereby are changed as follows:

Case No. Z-2936

Zone Change from the "B" Multiple-Family Dwelling District to the "LC" Light Commercial District

Lots 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10, Walnut Street, and Lots 22, 24, 26, 28 and 30, Texas Street, all in WEST WICHITA ADDITION, Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

Generally located on the east side of Walnut Street between Burton and Texas.

SECTION 2. That upon the taking effect of the Ordinance, the above zoning change shall be entered and shown on the "Official Zoning Map" previously adopted by reference, and said official zoning map is hereby reincorporated as a part of the Zoning Ordinance as amended.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official City paper.
