At its regular meeting on **December 22, 2020** the Wichita City Council considered the above captioned request. The action of the Council was to **APPROVE** the request in accordance with the attached ordinance and conditions of approval.

CUP2020-00041 Conditions of Approval

1. The CUP drawing shall be revised to include the details of this amendment. The Parcel Description for Parcel 9 shall be amended to state the following under Proposed Use:
 - a. Shopping Center, Financial Institution, Office, Personal Services, Restaurant, Retail Sales, and other uses as permitted by the LI zoning district.
2. The site shall be developed in substantial conformance with the revised provisions of the approved CUP.
3. The applicant shall submit four copies of the amended and approved CUP within 60 days of final approval to the Metropolitan Area Planning Department or the amendment shall be deemed null and void.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS OR DISTRICTS OF CERTAIN LANDS LOCATED IN THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, UNDER THE AUTHORITY GRANTED BY THE WICHITA-SEDGWICK COUNTY UNIFIED ZONING CODE, SECTION V-C, AS ADOPTED BY SECTION 28.04.010, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That having received a recommendation from the Planning Commission, and proper notice having been given and hearing held as provided by law and under authority and subject to the provisions of The Wichita-Sedgwick County Unified Zoning Code, Section V-C, as adopted by Section 28.04.010, as amended, the zoning classification or districts of the lands legally described hereby are changed as follows:

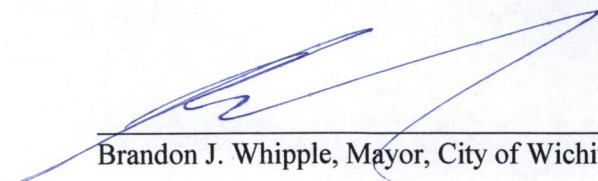
City zone change from LC Limited Commercial to LI Limited Industrial zoning lot described as:

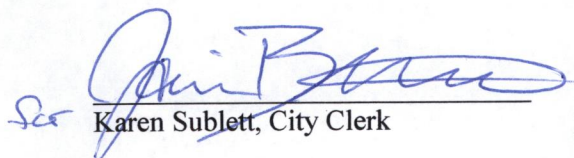
Lot 5, Block 1, The Home Depot Addition, Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption and publication in the official City paper.

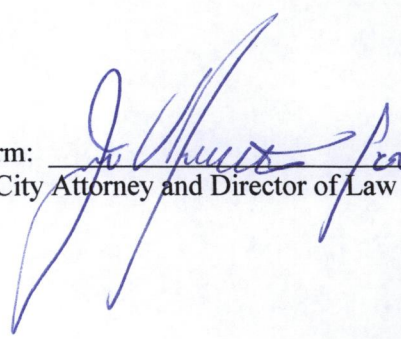

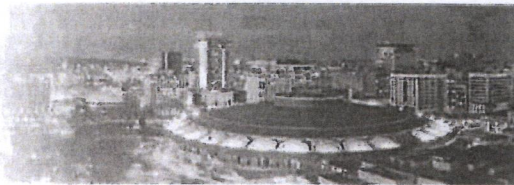

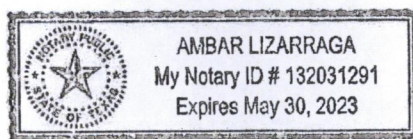
