

At their meeting of February 18, 1958, the City Planning Commission considered subject dedications recently received from your department. The Planning Commission has declined to recommend acceptance of these dedications until additional dedications are presented to provide for a cul-de-sac at the western end of the street so dedicated.

The Planning Commission has, therefore, directed the administrative staff to attempt to obtain appropriate dedications for the cul-de-sac.

Inasmuch as your department has handled the original street dedications, it is considered appropriate that your department attempt to obtain the additional dedications suggested. The Planning staff will assist in this matter in any way possible upon request.

This is in answer to your memo of February 20, 1958, relative to the above subject.

You ask that the engineering division attempt to obtain additional dedications which would permit a cul-de-sac at the western end of Newell Street and which would tie-in with the above referred to dedications.

I ask that you review the city map relative to Newell Street. You will find that in the area west of Sheridan there are three pieces of Newell Street, one east of Westridge, one east of Kessler, and now the newly dedicated section west of Kessler.

It is the thinking of the Public Works Department that eventually these three portions will be tied together and further that Newell Street will be extended both east and west so that it will be a continuous street between Sheridan and West Street, in which case no cul-de-sac will be needed. Further, the cul-de-sac which the Planning Commission has requested is in an unplatted area and it seems wise to wait for the platting of this area rather than force in an unneeded cul-de-sac.

Under these circumstances I would suggest that the Planning Commission reconsider this request.
