



Neighborhood Development Program - General  
Urban Renewal Plan

Recently you informally reviewed with Ken Kitchen, the Executive Director of the Urban Renewal Agency, the proposed activities for the second year in the Neighborhood Development Plan area. These activities included land acquisition for parks, Board of Education, Local Housing Authority, and for public redevelopment. Also included is the relocation of 21st Street approximately one block south of the intersection of Broadway and 21st Street.

Since there is no written material on these proposals, other than the original revised map, we have requested Mr. Kitchen to attend your meeting in the event of questions. If you concur with the proposals, it is recommended that you adopt a resolution finding the General Urban Renewal Plan in conformity with the Comprehensive Plan.
