Dear Mr. Allen:

This letter is to indicate to you that the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area Planning Department has reviewed your proposal for constructing a multi-purpose Neighborhood Facility within a community park in the vicinity of 25th Street and Arkansas Avenue.

Although the adopted Comprehensive Development Plan for the Wichita-Sedgwick County Metropolitan Area does not have an individual multi-purpose neighborhood facility plan element, the facility you propose is considered to be consistent with the development goals and guidelines for the community as set forth more specifically in the adopted "Open Space, Parks and Recreation Plan" element of the Comprehensive Plan and in the Land Use Plan elements in general. This is particularly true in light of the high degree of coordination your department has carried out with other agencies, organizations and citizens groups in putting the proposed project together.

These efforts are obvious in that your proposal conforms very closely to the neighborhood plan in the process of preparation for the Waco-Finn Rehabilitation Project area by the local Urban Renewal Agency and too the plans and programs of the Wichita City Demonstration Agency and the Wichita Area Community Action Program, Inc.
