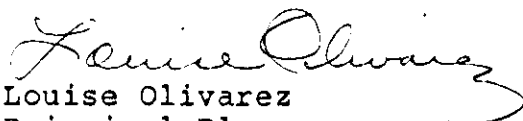
Dear Mr. Brinda:
