ORDINANCE NO. 38-196

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN PLATTED BUILDING SETBACKS BETWEEN LOTS 2 AND 3 IN BLOCK 1, STONEHEDGE, AN ADDITION TO WICHITA, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. That the platted building setbacks described as follows, to-wit:

The east 15.00 feet of the south 72.00 feet of Lot 2, Block 1, and the west 12.50 feet of the south 72.50 feet of Lot 3, Block 1, Stonehedge, An Addition to Wichita, Sedgwick County, Kansas; (MAPC NO. V-1253);

be and the same are hereby vacated in accordance with K.S.A. 13-443, subject however, to the concurrence in such vacation by the Board of County Commissioners as by law provided.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby recommended to the Board of County Commissioners of Sedgwick County, Kansas, that said above described setbacks be vacated by said Board in case a proper petition is filed under the provisions of K.S.A. 12-504, 12-505 and K.S.A. 12-506.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
