SUBJECT: V-1378 - VACATION OF A PORTION OF A PLATTED BUILDING
SETBACK, GENERALLY LOCATED AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER
OF 29TH STREET NORTH AND SALINA.

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of building setback.

Background: Donald G. and Sherry L. Abraham, 1043 West 29th Street North, Wichita, KS 67204, have requested this vacation in order to allow more buildable area. After vacation, a 15-foot wide building setback will remain.

Analysis: The Planning Commission recommends the City Commission find: (1) that no private rights will be injured or endangered; and (2) the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience by granting by order the vacation, subject to:

1. Proper publication of notice of public hearing;
2. The absence of proper written protest filed with the City Clerk; and
3. All proceedings being without cost to the City, County or any utility company.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk certifies as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing; approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to owner.

1. That due and legal notice has been given by publication as required by law, by publication in the Daily Record of notice of this vacation proceeding for consecutive weeks on MARCH 5 & 12, 1986.
2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described building setback, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.
3. In justice to the petitioner(s) the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.
4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.
5. The vacation of the building setback described herein should be approved.
