SUBJECT: PUBLIC HEARING V-1579 REQUEST TO VACATE A PLATTED UTILITY EASEMENT, LOCATED NORTH OF SHANNON WAY IN AN AREA EAST OF ROCK ROAD. (District #2)

INITIATED BY: Metropolitan Area Planning Department

AGENDA ACTION: Planning

Staff Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement.

MAPC Recommendation: Approve vacation of utility easement. (unanimous)

Background: Planned improvements associated with a swimming pool would encroach an existing utility easement used by K.G. & E. The applicant has made arrangements for the relocation of existing utilities within this easement and the utility Advisory Committee and City Engineering have indicated that no adverse effects will result from this vacation. The vacation request has been reviewed and approved by the Planning Commission, subject to conditions.

Legal Considerations: The City Clerk needs to certify as to proper notification and no filing of written protest.

Recommendations/Action: Close public hearing, approve vacation; authorize the Mayor to sign the Vacation Order; and record certified copy of Order, recording costs to be billed to:

2. No private rights will be injured or endangered by the vacation of the above-described utility easement, and the public will suffer no loss or inconvenience thereby.

3. In justice to the petitioner(s), the prayer of the petition ought to be granted.

4. No written objection to said vacation has been filed with the City Clerk by any owner or adjoining owner who would be a proper party to the petition.

5. The north eight (8) feet of utility easement as described in the above legal description shall be retained as a utility easement.

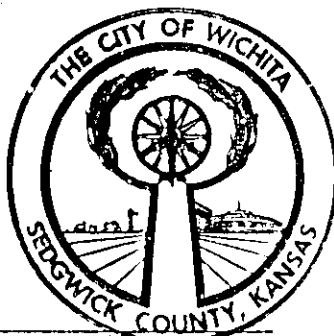
6. The vacation of the utility easement described herein should be approved.
